Further explore the jewels of Russia's capital and delve deep into its Cold War and pre-revolutionary past. The largest city located entirely on the European continent, Moscow has served as the capital of no fewer than five Russian states, from the medieval Grand Duchy of Moscow and the Tsardom of Russia to the Russian Empire, the Soviet Union and today's Russian Federation. It possesses a fascinating and dynamic blend of cultural, political and economic history, yet stands as testament to Russia's contemporary flourish and future ambitions, all while maintaining a classic Russian love of the arts.

Ride the Moscow Metro, where train stations are museums in their own right. The regal stations showcase Soviet artists, values and icons—their hallways, like *Taganskaya's* (pictured left), are an architectural tapestry of Russia's grand narrative. Tour the fascinating Cold War Museum at the Bunker-42 on Taganka, a former secret military complex. Located 213 feet below ground, this elaborate facility was built in the 1950s in response to nuclear threats. Visit the acclaimed State Tretyakov Gallery, home to one of the world's finest and most extensive collections of Russian icons and art, spanning

1000 years; the Armoury Palace Museum, the oldest museum in Russia, to see the world's largest collection of Imperial Fabergé eggs; and the Tolstoy House Museum, where author Leo Tolstoy lived in 1882.
