



Journey aboard an exclusively chartered train to Machu Picchu, one of the world's most astonishing archaeological treasures.

NOVEMBER 1 - 3

Discover the extraordinary UNESCO World Heritage site of Machu Picchu and examine its artfully cut stone altars, temples, foundation, staircases and terraced gardens. Explore the Convent of Santo Domingo, built atop the ruins of Koricancha, formerly the main Inca temple of Cusco. Attend a weaving demonstration by a master Andean weaver and shop for woven treasures.

ACCOMMODATIONS

You will stay at the **Belmond Hotel Monasterio**. This historic property, housed in an ancient monastery, offers uniquely designed rooms and is an elegant oasis located just steps from the Plaza de Armas.

ALTERNATE If you've already visited Machu Picchu, consider traveling to Peru's lesserknown North Coast, a region filled with stunning natural scenery and archaeological wonders from several pre-Incan cultures.

ALTERNATE Enjoy attentive and warm service at the Costa del Sol Trujillo Centro, boasting a central location on the city's main plaza just minutes from the area's archaeological sites. Spend a night at the **Hotel Paracas**, a resort located on the Peruvian coastal town of Pisco surrounded by the Paracas National Reserve.







EASTER ISLAND



EXPEDITION HIGHLIGHT

Take to the stage before a festive dinner complete with elaborately costumed entertainers performing traditional Polynesian song and dance.

NOVEMBER 4 - 5

Journey to the heart of Easter Island where a long-lost civilization comes to life before our eyes. Near the town of Hanga Roa we encounter Ahu Tahai, the site of three restored *moai*, and explore the Rano Raraku quarry where almost 400 giant statues remain in various stages of completion, giving us fascinating insights into how these mysterious icons may have been created. Visit Ahu Akivi, considered to be a particularly sacred site and home to seven *moai*, all of which are positioned to face sunset during the spring equinox and have their backs to the sunrise during the autumn equinox.

Discover the Orongo ceremonial village, where the famous "birdman" competition was held. Winning this dangerous race was the fastest route to prestige and power in Rapa Nui society. Opt to capture images of the mysterious *moai* in the special light of the morning sun during a sunrise photoshoot.



ACCOMMODATIONS

The property of **Nayara Hangaroa** was designed in homage to the ceremonial village of Orongo. Inspired by the architectural shapes of caves, rooms are smooth, cozy and organic, built with natural materials like cypress logs, clay and volcanic rock.





NOVEMBER 8 - 9

Enjoy your luxury hotel's enviable location and take in spectacular views of the Australian coast and proximity to the marvels of the Great Barrier Reef, a UNESCO World Heritage site.

The Great Barrier Reef is the world's largest coral reef system, composed of roughly 3,000 individual reefs and 900 islands stretching for over 1,600 miles. Snorkel or dive among a collection of coral and tropical fish, or stay on land to beachcomb and trek along the picturesque sands.

Choose to embark on a private cruise of the Great Barrier Reef, where you'll glide across the crystalclear waters. Or opt to visit the wonders of the Daintree Rainforest alongside an Aboriginal guide. Together you'll journey through the Mossman Gorge, a rainforest sanctuary of rare and exotic fruit trees and wildlife facing extinction.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Set on nearly 10 acres, the **Pullman** Port Douglas Sea Temple Resort and Spa features extensive gardens and water features, including a lagoon-style pool, pool with waterfalls and pool bar. Guest rooms are equipped with modern amenities and private balconies or terraces.

Experience the ancient Thommanon Temple during a private, after-hours evening of cocktails, dinner and entertainment.

NOVEMBER 10 - 12

Angkor Wat is the world's largest religious structure built from stone. Opt for an earlymorning visit to beat the mid-morning heat, tour the complex and meet with Buddhist monks for a blessing. Alternatively, explore this UNESCO World Heritage site after breakfast and discover why it is also known as "the city of temples." Visit Ta Prohm, a prominent temple left in a state similar to the way it appeared when it was discovered. Move on to Bayon, a richly adorned temple that served as the center of Jayavarman VII's capital.

Take a tour by boat of Tonle Sap, Southeast Asia's largest freshwater lake, passing Chong Khneas Floating Village, which features floating shops, churches and schools. Peruse

the bustling Siem Reap Market where locals sell clothing, spices, housewares, fresh food and handicrafts; or visit the workshops and showroom of Artisans d'Angkor, an organization that trains young people in traditional crafts.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Located just five miles from Angkor Wat, Raffles Grand Hotel d'Angkor has been restored to its original colonial architecture and features steam baths, a 35-meter lap pool and shops full of local crafts. Rooms are appointed with high ceilings and four-poster beds.



TAJ MAHAL AND JAIPUR



EXPEDITION HIGHLIGHT

Gaze upon the marble majesty of the Taj Mahal, perhaps the world's most famous building.



NOVEMBER 13 - 14

The private jet delivers us to Agra for a day visit to one of history's greatest masterpieces, the Taj Mahal. Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan commissioned this astoundingly beautiful monument in the 17th century as a tribute to the memory of his beloved second wife. Explore this enchanting work of art, which incorporates and expands on Persian, Hindu and Islamic styles.

Next, immerse yourself in the vibrant tapestry of culture, cuisine and architecture of Jaipur, nicknamed the "Pink City" for its striking rose-colored buildings. In the heart of Jaipur stands the majestic City Palace, home to the royal family's vast collection of textiles, costumes, paintings and carpets.

Visit the Jantar Mantar, an open-air observatory and UNESCO World Heritage site featuring 19 astronomical structures, including the world's largest sundial. Join Hindu worshippers for a visit to Govind Dev Ji Temple, a sacred pilgrimage site for devotees of Lord Krishna. Participate in a morning aarti, in which a flame is offered to the deity along with songs and prayers.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Built in 1835, Rambagh Palace was home to Jaipur's royal family until 1957, when it was converted into a hotel. The property includes over 47 acres of expansive gardens. Relax and recharge at the holistic spa or indulge in a fine dinner at one of several unique bars and restaurants.

NOVEMBER 15 - 17

Embark on an unforgettable safari adventure in a world-class wildlife destination—the Serengeti Plain. This vast landscape teems with a dizzying array of animals, including wildebeests, giraffes, elephants, lions and black rhinos, as well as more than 500 species of birds. Set off on half-day or all-day game drives across the vast plains, which serve as the backdrop to one of the most ancient migration rituals on Earth.


ALTERNATE If you'd like to see a different side of Tanzania, opt to visit the Ngorongoro Crater, the largest unbroken caldera in the world. Alongside expert naturalist guides, witness its permanent population of about 25,000 animals, including bull elephants, black rhinos and lions.

NOVEMBER 18 - 19

Nearly two-thirds of Jordan is covered by great expanses of arid desert. Gold-tinged red sandstone cliffs arch up into the sky, while plateaus eroded by winds stretch toward the horizon. In the middle of this stark beauty lies Petra. Built in the first century as capital of the Nabataean Arabs, Petra is one of the most famous archaeological sites in the world. Walk through the Siq, a narrow chasm in the bedrock, and emerge before the elaborate Treasury. Take a stroll through the site, stopping to view the wares sold by local vendors. Depart early, allowing time to hike up to the harder-to-reach sites, or depart mid-morning for a more leisurely visit.

In addition, explore the spectacular rock formations of Wadi Rum, an evocative lunarlike landscape made famous by T.E. Lawrence and the film Lawrence of Arabia. Opt to discover Wadi Rum on a 4x4 expedition, or choose to experience the Bedouin way of life with an upgraded stay at a luxury camp in this unspoiled desert wilderness.

ACCOMMODATIONS

With its close proximity to the sights, the Mövenpick Resort Petra is an ideal home base that blends Middle Eastern craftsmanship, modern conveniences and stunning views of the desert landscape.

NOVEMBER 20 - 21

Lying at the foot of the Atlas Mountains, Marrakech has some of the most impressive examples of Islamic architecture in existence. Stroll the narrow, maze-like streets of this ancient walled quarter and visit the Koutoubia Mosque and the Ben Youssef Madrasa.

Visit the Yves Saint Laurent Museum and the Majorelle Garden with its marble pools, raised pathways, bamboo groves, coconut palms and bougainvillea. After years of neglect, the garden was taken over and restored in the 1920s by fashion designer Yves Saint Laurent and his partner Pierre Bergé. Or opt to spend a day in the spectacular scenery of the Atlas Mountains with the chance to visit a Berber village and share tea with the village chief.

With Moorish gardens and restful swimming pools, Four Seasons **Resort Marrakech** offers a peaceful oasis.
