





With its myriad cultural offerings, from the elegiac to ornate, Berlin is a touchstone city for the discerning traveler, as is its neighboring treasure of Dresden. One of Europe's preeminent centers of history, art and music, Berlin is known for its world-class museums, grand opera house and eclectic architecture, and is an excellent commencement to your program. Learn more about the city firsthand on a guided tour, where you will view the Reichstag Building, constructed to house the Imperial Diet of the German Empire; the Neoclassical Brandenburg Gate, one of Germany's most well-known landmarks; and the solemn Holocaust Memorial, consisting of nearly five acres of concrete slabs, or stelae, organized in a disorienting pattern designed by architect Peter Eisenman to represent a supposedly ordered system that has lost touch with human reason.

Cruise through Berlin's enchanting waterways on the Spree River, beginning and ending by the *Haus der Kulturen der Welt*, a "lighthouse of culture" sculpted from heavy bronze. See the popular sights that line the banks, including the Berlin Cathedral and other architectural highlights.

Later, explore the captivating Pergamon Museum on the UNESCO World Heritage-designated



Museum Island and the fascinating Wall Museum at historic Checkpoint Charlie, the former border crossing between East and West Berlin.

En route to Prague, visit oft-overlooked Dresden, known as the “Jewel Box of Germany” for its splendid Baroque and Rococo architecture and its cultural and artistic significance. On the walking tour, Frauenkirche, which is considered an outstanding example of Protestant sacred architecture and features one of the largest domes in Europe.

Budapest's House of Parliament, the largest building in Hungary, is crowned with an elegant dome soaring 226 feet into the sky.
