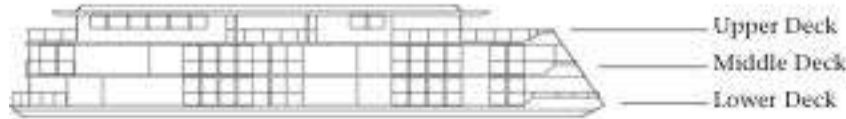




MS ZAMBEZI QUEEN AMENITIES

The crew is trained in "Remote Area First Aid," but there is no physician on board. Severe medical problems will require evacuation at the participant's expense.
