


MS ZAMBEZI QUEEN AMENITIES

The following information provides further details about the ship featured on this travel program and its amenities.

Stateroom Features

The MS ZAMBEZI QUEEN offers 14 tastefully furnished staterooms featuring magnificent views from floor-to-ceiling windows. An outer deck allows you to step outside to experience the African breeze. Staterooms can be configured with either double or two single beds.

Currency

The U.S. dollar is the official currency on board the ship. Visa credit cards, South African rand and Botswana pula are also accepted. Participants may sign for beverages and purchases on board and settle their account prior to disembarkation.

The ship does not maintain a currency exchange.

Smoking policy

The MS ZAMBEZI QUEEN has a nonsmoking policy. Smoking is permitted only on the aft deck in designated areas.

Dining

The MS ZAMBEZI QUEEN'S dining room accommodates all guests at one unassigned, single seating. Menus feature African fusion cuisine. The ship's restaurant staff will do their best to accommodate special dietary requests (i.e. vegetarian, low sodium, etc.). Medical Services

The crew is trained in "Remote Area First Aid," but there is no physician on board. Severe medical problems will require evacuation at the participant's expense. Participants should bring a sufficient supply of required prescription medicines and basic first aid needs, as they will not be available on board.
