

Maori Culture



More than one thousand years ago, the Maori people came to New Zealand from their ancestral homeland of Hawaiki, arriving in *waka hourua* (voyaging canoes) to bring their native tribal language and ancient traditions. The natural beauty of the islands and rich volcanic soil that first attracted them also drew Dutch, English, and French explorers in the early 19th century. Today, the Maori make up more than 14 percent of the New Zealand population, many working to keep their proud legacy intact. Our unique itinerary allows you to immerse yourself in the unique Maori heritage and enjoy firsthand the friendly Kiwi culture—a distinctive merging of the *tangata whenua* (indigenous) and *Pakeha* (European) traditions.

DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Home City/Cross the International Date Line

Day 1 and Day 2

Depart home city and cross the International Date Line.

Auckland, New Zealand

Day 3

Arrive in Auckland and enjoy time at leisure before boarding LE LAPÉROUSE.

Auckland

Day 4

See modern skyscrapers juxtaposed with restored Victorian buildings on a panoramic drive through downtown Auckland, known as the "City of Sails." Stop to take a photo at Bastion point with views of the city and harbor.

Visit the Auckland War Memorial Museum, dedicated to those who sacrificed their lives for their country, and see its collection of collection of Polynesian artifacts.

Attend the Captain's Welcome Reception on board the ship.

Tauranga for Rotorua

Day 5

Journey to the "thermal city" of Rotorua to experience rich Maori culture and other spectacular marvels. Visit Te Puia, located in the Whakarewarewa Geothermal Valley, to see the boiling mud pools and cascading Pohutu geyser that make Rotorua

famous. Finish your tour with a lively Maori performance, including the world-famous *haka*.

Napier

Day 6

Travel to Marewa, a tiny suburb that showcases Napier's homes from the 1930s and 1940s, noted for their use of modern geometrical designs, and see its iconic Art Deco Precinct. The township was originally laid out in the 1850s, but most of the town center was destroyed in 1931 by the Hawke's Bay earthquake.

Some of the architectural landmarks on your tour include the Municipal Theatre, the former Hotel Central, and the Masonic Hotel.

Return to the Art Deco Trust building where you will see a short movie documenting the journey through the immediate aftermath of the earthquake and the determination that resulted in the city being rebuilt over the course of two years.

Wellington

Day 7

Wellington is the world's southernmost capital city and New Zealand's center of government and kiwi culture. On a panoramic drive, see the Wellington waterfront, the Beehive (which houses the executive wing), and Oriental Bay.

Visit Old St. Paul's Cathedral and Te Papa Tongarewa, the national museum of New Zealand. The Maori name literally translates as "container of treasures."

Day at Sea

Day 8

Cruise the Tasman Sea and attend educational lectures on board the ship.

Milford Sound

Day 9

Milford, Doubtful, and Dusky Sounds comprise Fiordland National Park, which is a part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site, Te Wahipounamu. From the ship, look for the Little (Blue) Penguin, New Zealand fur seals, and the Bottlenose Dolphin. See spectacular scenery as the ship enters Milford Sound—which author Rudyard Kipling referred to as the Eighth Wonder of the World.

Dusky Sound

Day 10

Cruise through Dusky Sound for views of dramatic wilderness, cliffs, sheer cliffs, and tumbling waterfalls. Look for cormorants, seagulls and New Zealand fur seals on Zodiac excursions. In 1773, the British navigator James Cook spent a few weeks

at Dusky Sound, which is noted by a plaque that can be seen at Astronomer's Point.

Dunedin

Day 11

Soak up the grandeur of Dunedin's architecture, lively business district, and famous Octagon city center with a panoramic drive that includes stops at St. Paul's Cathedral, the First Church of Otago, and the Dunedin Rail Station.

Visit Olveston House, a 35-room, early 20th century

Jacobean-style mansion, and Larnach Castle on the crown of a wooded hill overlooking Otago Harbour—formed by a violent volcano more than 10 million years ago.

Enjoy the Captain's Farewell Reception this evening.

Christchurch/ Return to home city

Day 12

Drive to Hagley Park to visit the Mona Vale Gardens, whose grounds include a lily pond, rose garden,

and fern conservatory. See areas affected by the 2011 Canterbury earthquake and discover how they are rebuilding the city. Visit the Canterbury Earthquake Memorial, which includes the Memorial Wall and the Bridge of Remembrance along the River Avon, and continue your tour to Regent Street, where you will walk to Cathedral Square in the city center.

After lunch transfer to the Christchurch airport for your flight home.
