



DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Depart Home City/ Lisbon, Portugal/ Embark Ship

Day 1 and Day 2

Depart your home city for Lisbon, Portugal. Arrive and embark the WIND STAR. Enjoy the Captain's Welcome Reception that evening.

Portimão, the Algarve, for Lagos

Day 3

En route to Lagos, admire Ponta de Piedade, a group of coastal limestone rock formations along the Algarve coast. Continue on to the port town of Lagos, once the center of trade between Moorish Portugal and Africa. Visit the statue of the Infante and the Church of St. Anthony, with its intricate carved wood interior. Built in 1707 and re-built after an earthquake in 1755, the church is a fine example of Baroque architecture.

Cádiz, Spain, for Seville

Day 4

Visit Seville's Gothic cathedral, Europe's second largest Christian house of worship after St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. Inside, see the world's largest altarpiece, a masterfully gilded woodcarving created over the course of 44 years by Flemish craftsman Pierre Dancart, along with masterpieces by Francisco Goya, Francisco Zurbarán, and Bartolomé Murillo.

Later, see the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Alcázar, the 14th-century residence of Seville's Moroccan and

Spanish rulers. Enjoy a traditional flamenco performance on the ship.

Gibraltar, British Overseas Territory/ Tangier, Morocco

Day 5

Visit the Rock of Gibraltar, considered by the ancient Greeks and Romans to be one of the two Pillars of Hercules that marked the boundary of the known world.

On the "Top of the Rock," the nearly 1,400-foot-high limestone promontory, enjoy

Day 6

In Granada explore the Alhambra Palace and brilliant gardens of the Palace of Generalife, collectively a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Originally designed as a military area, the Alhambra became the residence of royalty and of the court of Granada in the middle of the 13th century, and later

the view from Europa Point across the strait separating Europe and Africa. Observe the Barbary macaques, the only wild monkeys in Europe, and see the geological wonders in St. Michael's Cave.

In Tangier, experience the bridging of Spanish and Moorish cultures in the colorful medina. Visit the Kasbah museum; the Grand Socco market; and the American Legation, the center of diplomatic relations between the U.S. and Morocco.

a citadel with high ramparts and defensive towers.

Stroll through the gardens of the Generalife, the former rural residence of the emirs who ruled this part of Spain in the 13th and 14th centuries.

Day 7

Day 8

On the *Costa del Azahar* (Orange Blossom Coast) of Spain, the sun-kissed city of Valencia was founded as a Roman colony in 138 B.C. amidst a fertile plain of orange groves. Discover life along the historic cobblestone streets of colorful Plaza de la Reina, with views of St. Mary's Cathedral.

Marvel at the grand, UNESCO World Heritage-inscribed La Lonja de la Seda de Valencia, originally dedicated to the Iberian silk trade and considered a masterpiece of late Gothic architecture.

Tarragona

Day 9

Visit the historical hillside port of Tarragona on the *Cost Daurada* (Golden Coast), once one of the wealthiest seaports in the Roman Empire.

Highlights of the city's walled Old Town include the Tarragona Cathedral, the Plaza de La Font, and what remains of the Roman Circus—an ancient 30,000-spectator hippodrome. Enjoy the Captain's Farewell Reception this evening.
