Historic Old Havana

### Day 1 | Miami, Florida | Havana, Cuba

Depart Miami for Havana. Arrive, transfer and check in to your boutique hotel.

**Welcome Dinner.** Gather with your fellow travelers for dinner at a privately owned and operated local restaurant. Meet and support local entrepreneurs on your first night in Cuba!

### Day 2 | Havana

**Enrichment: Havana's Architecture.**

**Old Havana Guided Walk.** Enjoy your first look at La Habana Vieja, Old Havana, and its four main squares: Plaza de Armas, Plaza de San Francisco, Plaza de la Catedral and Plaza Vieja. These vibrant plazas teem with local life, from men playing dominoes to artists performing and vendors selling wares. Continue to Dador, an independently owned clothing store founded by Cuban women. Engage with the staff to gain an understanding of their creativity and spirit, the challenges they overcame and the rewards of starting and owning a female-led business. Stop for a casual Cuban lunch in Old Havana.

**Enrichment: The Cuban Economy.**

### Day 3 | Havana

**Norma Guillard.** Meet distinguished Cuban social psychologist and adjunct lecturer at the University of Havana, Norma Guillard. Watch "Maestra," a documentary about the female volunteers who taught over 700,000 Cubans to read and write during the 1961 Cuban Literacy Campaign. Guillard will share stories about her involvement at age 15, and her support of the LGBTQ community and women in low-income neighborhoods, followed by a discussion.

**National Museum of Fine Arts.** Join Wilfredo Benítez of the Ludwig Foundation, who will offer insightful commentary as he guides you on a tour of this important Cuban cultural institution. The museum houses a diverse collection of Cuban and European art, including colonial-era, 19th-century, modern and revolutionary works. Discuss your morning's insights over lunch.

**Vintage Convertible.** Hop into a classic 1950s American convertible for a ride along Havana's Malecón sea drive. Peek beneath the hood and chat with your friendly driver to appreciate their resourcefulness in maintaining the vintage cars.

### Day 4 | Havana

**Enrichment: Empowering Cuban Women.**

**Jewish Culture & Cuban Dance.** Visit the Ashkenazi Community Center to learn about Cuba's Jewish culture. Then, stop at Malpaso, a contemporary dance studio, to spend time with the dancers and gain insight into their

passion, training and dedication to dance.

**La Finca Vigía.** Visit Ernest Hemingway's modest home, where he lived from 1939 to 1960 and wrote "The Old Man and the Sea."

**Ludwig Foundation.** Later, gather on the terrace of this nonprofit institution, dedicated to protecting and promoting Cuban artists and culture. Engage in intellectual exchanges with local artists to understand their unwavering commitment to pursuing artistic ventures.

Enjoy dinner and discussion together tonight.

#### **Day 5 | Havana | Matanzas**

---

**Matanzas.** Drive to the province of Matanzas today while gazing at scenic views of the lush Yumurí Valley. In Matanzas, pass through the historic French Quarter and see once-elegant Spanish colonial mansions. Stop to visit the San Severino Castle, built in 1735. Then, stroll through La Libertad Park to witness Cuban freedom monuments. Next, visit the preserved French-style Museo Farmacéutico, founded in 1882. Admire its collection of North American stained-glass medicine bottles and antique

French porcelain jars during your guided visit.

**Choir Performance.** Delight in a local choir performance, followed by a brief Q&A session with the talented, dedicated choir members.

Relax over lunch at a nearby restaurant.

**Sugar Mill Triunvirato.** On a visit to this 19th-century sugar plantation and site of the 1843 Slave Rebellion, view the Monument to the Slave Rebellion and explore the Sugar Mill Museum, housed in the former overseer's quarters, to learn about daily life in the 1800s.

#### **Day 6 | Havana**

---

**Enrichment: Race & the Cuban Revolution.**

**Agromercado.** Experience daily Cuban life at an authentic, bustling street food market.

**El Callejón de Hamel.** Stroll along this artsy, colorful alley, Cuba's oldest community art project and the hub of Afro-Cuban arts and culture. Immerse yourself in the vibrant street art and rumba drumming, while gaining insight into Cuba's diverse Afro-Cuban religions.

**Inside an Art Studio.** Then, visit Casa Fuster, the home and studio of Picasso-inspired Cuban painter and sculptor José Fuster. View the artist's vibrant mosaics and hear about his work, followed by an engaging lunch here.

**Note:** Itinerary may change due to local conditions. If an event must be canceled, it will be replaced with another People-to-People event.

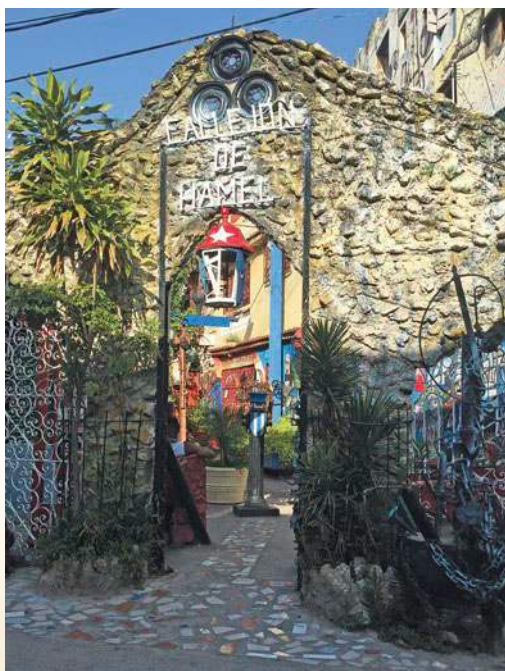

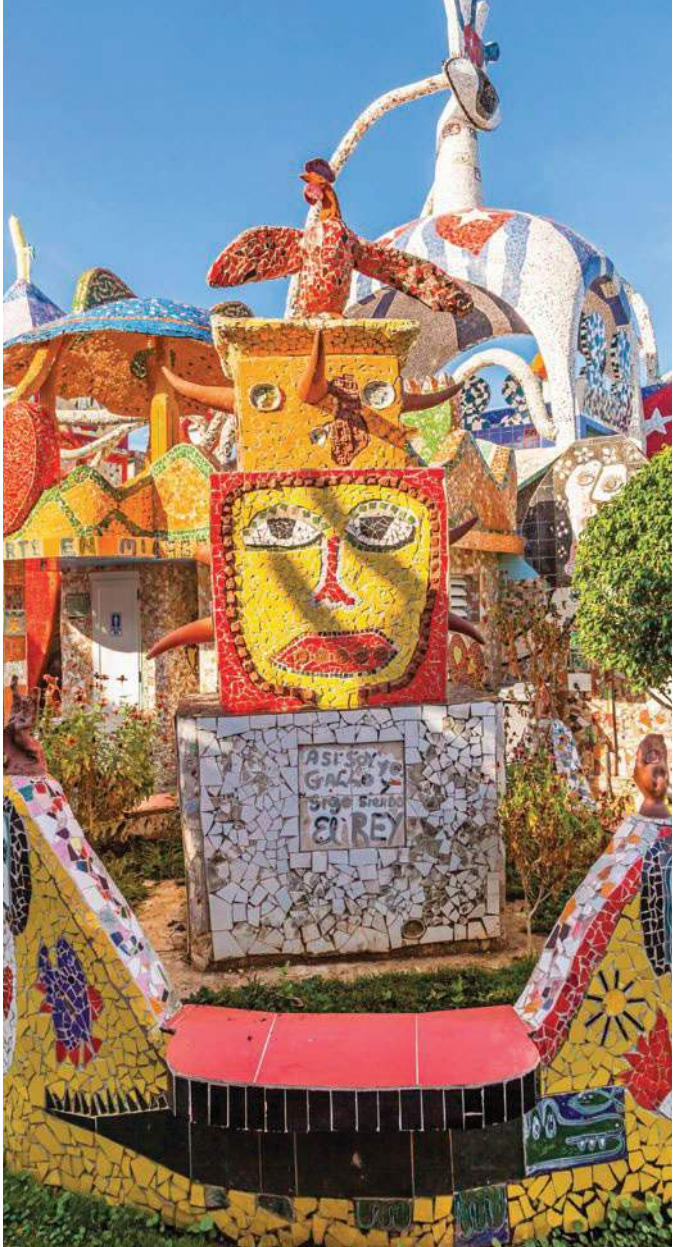
