Through the centuries, the Lake District of Italy has seduced the hearts, minds, and souls of artists and writers, including Lord Byron, William Wordsworth, Edith Wharton, and Ernest Hemingway. Long before the Romans annexed the region 2,000 years ago, it was settled by Etruscans and invaded by Celts. Following the Romans through the Renaissance, nobility built palatial villas, filled them with priceless art, and laid out extraordinary gardens. European aristocrats of the 18th and 19th centuries considered the Italian Lake District an essential stop on their “Grand Tour” of Europe, as chronicled in E.M. Forster’s *A Room With a View*. To this day, the mild climate and snowcapped Alpine peaks descending to lake shores continue to lure the wealthy, as well as celebrities and elite travelers from around the world. From the deep-blue glacial lakes of Como, Maggiore, and picturesque Orta to the enchanting Villa del Balbianello, and from colorful Bellagio—the “Pearl of Lake Como”—to the sophistication of Milan, discover the exquisite gem that is the Italian Lake District.

Milan, Italy/Como

Day 2

Arrive in Milan, Italy, and transfer to Como, the perfect “home” for our *soggiorno* in the spectacular mountainous Italian countryside. Check into the charming PALACE HOTEL on the shore of Lake Como. Join your traveling companions for a welcome reception.
