- —See Akureyri, known as Iceland's vibrant capital of the North, and journey inland to marvel at breathtaking natural wonders. Hear the roar of the spectacular Goðafoss waterfall, admire unusual rock formations in the craggy lava fields of Dimmuborgir, and revel in the stark, otherworldly, multicolored terrain that hisses and gurgles in the geothermal pass of Námaskarð.
