Enjoy a sampling of fresh truffle hors d'oeuvres, Champagne and various oils. After a Provencal buffet lunch, learn to play the game of pétanque!

Aix-en-Provence & Cézanne's Studio.

On today's guided tour, stroll upon the Cours Mirabeau, considered one of the most beautiful boulevards in Europe.

Then, immerse yourself in the artist's life with a Cézanne studio tour. Travel on to the sun-drenched fishing village of Cassis on the Mediterranean coast for a fresh seafood lunch before taking a relaxing cruise through the deep, narrow inlets of the Calanques.

Avignon & the Pond Du Gard. In Avignon, explore the impressive Palais des Papes—a fortress-like medieval masterpiece with "ramparts, towers and turrets—which sits on the banks of the Rhône River. After lunch, travel to the UNESCO World Heritage site of Pont du Gard, an ancient technical masterpiece with an enormous three-tiered aqueduct built by the Romans in 19 B.C.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Explore this historic Rhone wine region in the stunning countryside of southeastern France's Rhône Valley. Relish a winery tour and tasting of the powerful, full-bodied red wine.

Arles, Les Baux-de-Provence and Saint-Rémy-de-Provence. Journey to Arles for a guided tour to see the amphitheater of Les Arènes and the Cathédral Saint-Trophime, a masterpiece of Romanesque style. Then, in the hill town of Les Baux-de-Provence, see a glimpse of medieval life with its tiny squares and cobblestone streets. Travel to nearby Saint-Rémy-de-Provence to see the lush green, perfumed valleys that inspired Vincent Van Gogh's paintings. Visit Moulin de Calanquet, for a tour and tasting at this olive oil mill.

Marseille. Discover France's oldest city, founded around 600 B.C. by Greek settlers from Phocaea. Today, Marseille is a dazzling metropolis on the Mediterranean. On a guided coach and walking tour, see the Palais Longchamp, admire the magnificent view from Notre Dame de la Garde, and take a stroll through Le Panier, the oldest district of Marseille. Enjoy lunch and explore Marseille further at leisure this afternoon.

Lourmarin & Cucuron. Relish a panoramic tour of two of the most beautiful villages in the Luberon massif. Lourmarin was once home to Nobel Prize-winning author Albert Camus, and author Peter Mayle.
