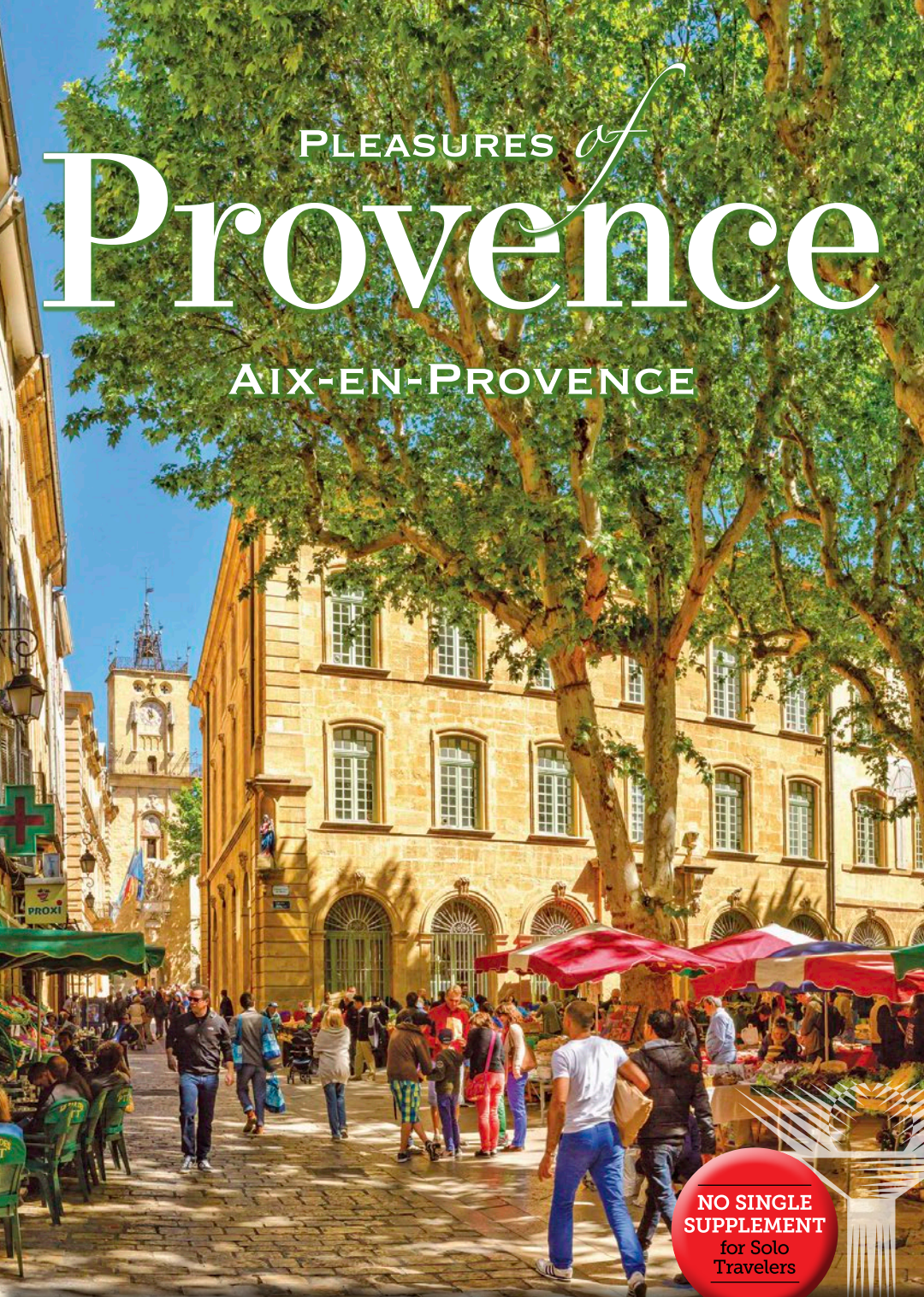

Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Marseille, France. 🌍

Day 2 | Marseille | Aix-en-Provence

Upon arrival, transfer 🚗 and check in to the Grand Hôtel Roi René Aix-en-Provence. Then, take a brief walking tour with your Travel Director to get acquainted with the area. Meet your fellow travelers at this evening's Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 3 | Aix-en-Provence | Cassis & its Calanques

Aix-en-Provence & Cézanne's Studio. Set out to explore this captivating capital of Provence, your home for the week. On a guided tour, stroll beneath a canopy of plane trees along the famed Cours Mirabeau, considered one of the most beautiful boulevards in Europe. Pass by the Cathedrale Saint-Sauveur d'Aix-en-Provence and Place de l'Hôtel de Ville. See the places Paul Cézanne frequented, such as Les Deux Garçons café, and where he found inspiration when he lived here. Then, find your muse during a visit to his *atelier*, imagining the artist at work.

Cassis & its Calanques. Next, drive to Cassis, a quaint, sun-drenched Provençal fishing village on the Mediterranean coast, to savor a fresh seafood lunch at a local restaurant. Continue on a boat cruise through the narrow inlets of the famous Calanques of Marseille to marvel at the unique geological formations of tall needle rocks rising from brilliant blue-green waters.

Day 4 | Avignon

Palais des Papes & Avignon. Revel in the history of this UNESCO-inscribed city with a guided, fascinating visit to the Gothic Pope's Palace,

a medieval masterpiece that served as the papal seat during the 14th century. Gaze in awe at its centuries-old frescoes and grand chambers, including the Pope's private apartments.

Savor lunch in colorful, enchanting Avignon.

Pont Du Gard. Continue to visit the remarkably preserved, UNESCO-inscribed Pont du Gard, built by the Romans in 19 B.C. Contemplate the awe-inspiring architectural grandeur of Roman engineering and construction mastery of this massive, three-tiered aqueduct.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Cap off the day with a scenic drive to the famed, historic wine making village of Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Once there, relish a guided tour and savor a tasting of the famed, full-bodied Rhône wine.

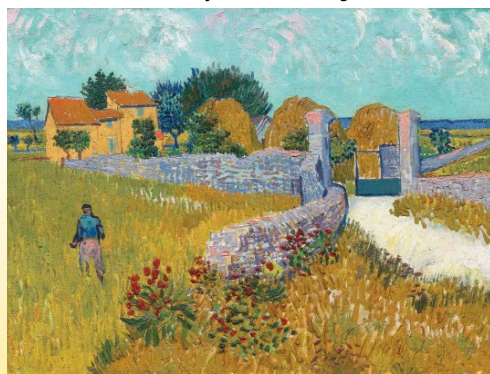
Day 5 | Arles, Les Baux & St. Remy

Arles. Embark on a walking tour of coastal Arles, brimming with UNESCO-inscribed monuments and Roman ruins, colorful pastel houses and artistic inspiration. Marvel at the colossal amphitheater of Les Arènes and the Cathedral of St. Trôphime, a masterpiece of Romanesque style. Wander the narrow, cobblestoned streets amid medieval buildings and pass by Café Van Gogh, which inspired Van Gogh's painting, "Café Terrace at Night."

Free Time: Explore more of Arles' artistic heritage during lunch and time at leisure.

Les Baux & St. Remy. Delight in visits to two quintessentially Provençal villages. Perched on a rocky outcrop, Les Baux offers a dramatic setting amid towering limestone cliffs with breathtaking views. Romantic St. Remy charms with the lush green, perfumed valleys that inspired Van Gogh to produce more than 150 paintings. Then, at Moulin de Calanquet, tour the local olive oil mill and savor a tasting.

Day 6 | Marseille

Marseille. This dazzling, vibrant port city on the Mediterranean coast is the oldest city in France, founded around 600 BC. On a coach and walking tour, appreciate the tapestry of diverse cultures, eclectic neighborhoods and architectural wonders. Pass by the Palais Longchamp and drive along the harbor up to Notre Dame de la Garde to take in the panoramic views. Then, absorb the city's mystery as you walk through bohemian Le Panier, the oldest district of Marseille.

Enjoy lunch and time at leisure to explore more of Marseille, perhaps by visiting the Museum of Civilizations of Europe and the Mediterranean. Savor the city's culinary offerings at leisure.

Day 7 | The Luberon

AHI Connects | Les Pastras Provence.

Venture out once again into the countryside to Les Pastras. Tour the organic farm and black truffle plantation and join professional hunters in the search for France's elusive "black gold." Then, indulge in a delectable tasting of fresh truffle hors d'oeuvres with Champagne.

After a Provençal buffet lunch amid the idyllic setting, learn to play the game of *pétanque*, or *boules*, accompanied by rosé and *pastis!*



Luberon Mountain Villages. Take in the idyllic views on a panoramic tour of two of the most lovely villages in the Luberon massif, Cucuron and Lourmarin, once home to Nobel prize-winning author, Albert Camus.

Day 8 | Aix-en-Provence

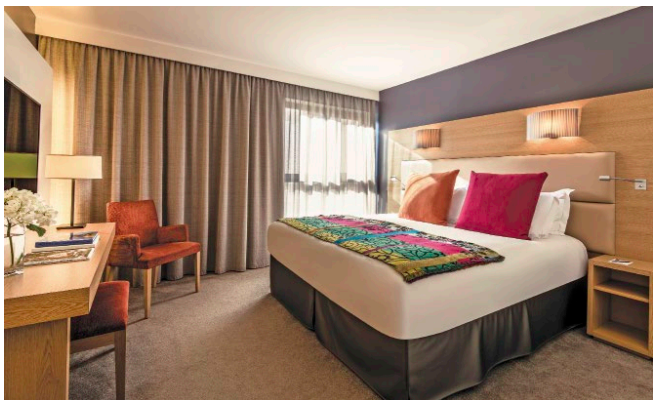
