Day 1| In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Athens, Greece.

Day 2 | Athens, Greece

Upon arrival, transfer **3** to the NJV Athens Plaza Hotel.

Gather with your fellow travelers for a Welcome Dinner to kick off your Greek odyssey.

Day 3 | Athens

Athens City Tour. Become acquainted with illustrious Athens, the birthplace of democracy. Admire the Academy of Athens, University of Athens, the National Library and other highlights on a panoramic tour. Then, travel up to the resplendent Acropolis with monuments built by ancient Greece's finest architects, sculptors and artists in the fifth century B.C. Take in the Parthenon's classical lines and sweeping city views. Later, at the Acropolis Museum, view splendid artifacts from the Acropolis' slopes and look through the glass floor to see the ruins of an ancient neighborhood. (Active)

Free Time: The rest of the day is yours to plan.

Day 4 | Mycenae | Kalamata

After checking out of the hotel, head toward Kalamata on the Peloponnese's southern coast.

Mycenae & Greek Wine. Take a guided tour of the impressive ruins of Mycenae, one of the oldest archaeological sites on the Peloponnese. The Mycenaean civilization flourished during the second millennium B.C. and was home to Agamemnon, the king who conquered Troy, according to Greek mythology. Imagine this

fortified city in all its glory as you walk under the imposing Lion's Gate. Then, sample fine Greek wines with lunch at a winery. (Active)

Depart for Kalamata and check in to the Pharae Palace Hotel.

Enrichment: Greek History.

As a special welcome to Kalamata, enjoy a cocktail and a wonderful buffet dinner tonight.

Day 5 | Kalamata | Messene

Enrichment: Classical Greece.

Kalamata's History & Cuisine. Stroll with your guide in Kalamata's charming old town and learn about the city's tumultuous past. As you listen to stories of Kalamata's history and see points of interest, stop to taste traditional foods like their world-famous, fruity, sharp olives and fresh seafood.

Try more specialties at lunch in the old town.

Messene. This afternoon, take a guided tour of an under-the-radar gem, the splendid, vast ruins of Messene set in a serene mountain valley. Unlike other sites, this ancient city

built around 369 B.C. was largely untouched by subsequent settlements, so its remains are remarkably intact. See its grand temples, agora, theater, stadium and more. *(Active)*

Day 6 | Sparta | Mystras

Sparta, Mystras & the Greek Olive. Walk with your guide through the ruins of ancient Sparta, one of Greece's most powerful city-states. Travel later to the stunning ruins of Mystras above the Laconian plain. In 1249, a Frankish prince built a castle there, which fell into the hands of the Byzantine Empire 13 years later. Over the next two centuries, Mystras evolved into the most important Byzantine city in the southern Peloponnese. Hear about its significance from your guide and admire the monasteries, chapels and churches adorned with frescoes. Finally, tour Sparta's Museum of the Olive and Greek Olive Oil, which details why the olive is prized by the Greeks. (Active)

Day 7 | Ancient Olympia

Ancient Olympia. This sacred site dedicated

Archaeological Museum, Olympia

to Zeus was the celebrated birthplace of the ancient Olympic Games, which were first played in his honor in 776 B.C. See where renowned sporting events were held, learn what the earliest Olympic games were like and stand at the runners' original starting line in the stadium! See the Temples of Zeus and Hera, then visit the Archaeological Museum to view beautiful sculptures from the temples, bronze artifacts and other marvelous finds.

Free Time: Choose a nice place in Olympia for lunch before returning to Kalamata.

Connects | *Greek Night.* Opa! Join hands for a joyful Kalamatianos folk dance at a fun-filled party with food, wine and music!

Day 8 | Kalamata

Enrichment: Contemporary Greece.





Free Time: Create your own agenda today! Unwind on the hotel's beach or relish a drink and lovely views at the rooftop lounge.

Tonight, embark on a sunset cruise along the Messinian Bay and raise a toast to your adventure with farewell drinks on board.

Day 9 | Corinth | Athens

This morning, depart Kalamata for Athens and stop in Corinth during your journey.

Corinth. Follow your guide on a fascinating walk through the archaeological site of ancient Corinth. See the Temple of Apollo and ruins from the Roman era when Corinth was a major colony and thriving center of trade. Afterward, check out the Corinth Canal, the deep channel that separates the Peloponnese from the mainland, which first opened in 1893.

Check in to the NJV Athens Plaza Hotel.

Free Time: Spend the remainder of your day in Athens sightseeing or shopping.

Day 9 | In Transit

After breakfast, transfer **>** to the airport for the return flight **\$** to your gateway city.
