INDIA –KOLKATA & THE GANGES RIVER WITH EXTENSIONS TO GOLDEN TRIANGLE & VARANASI Aboard the *Ganges Voyager* October 7 – 16, 2025 (10 days)

The journey begins in Kolkata (old Calcutta), the capital of India during British rule from 1772 to 1911, with one night at the luxurious Taj Bengal Hotel before boarding the 28-cabin *Ganges Voyager*. From its source high in the mighty Himalayas, this holiest of rivers, *Mother Ganga* to Indians, flows 1,500 miles south and east through areas Western visitors rarely see, connecting to the Hooghly River through Kolkata before emptying into the Bay of Bengal. A tapestry of varied religious beliefs, faith, awe-inspiring history, rich architecture and cultural heritage spreads along the river banks. Infused with influences of past rulers and European settlers, rich in diverse flora and fauna and boasting incredible landscapes, the Ganges and Hooghly Rivers represents the heart and soul of Indian civilization.

For those who are interested there is a pre-tour extension to the Golden Triangle beginning with Delhi, the capital of modern India as well as Muslim India between the 13th and 19th century. Continue to Agra to see the incomparable Taj Mahal, a UNESCO World heritage site. End with the Jaipur Palace and Amber fort before flying from Jaipur to Kolkata to start then main tour. A post tour extension includes Varanasi a pilgrimage site for Hindus and a center for learning situated on the banks of the Ganges River. Visit Sarnath, where Gautam Buddha achieved enlightenment and delivered his first sermon. Then fly to Delhi to visit the capital and the Taj Mahal in Agra.

In Murshidabad visit the Hazarduari Palace built in the early 19 th century in Greek Doric style and filled with colonial era antiques; take local buggy to Katra Mosque dating back to the early 18 th century. Tuesday, October 14	Mayapur	Ganges Voyager	Mayapur is the headquarters of the International Society of Krishna Consciousness where a temple comparable in size to the Vatican was funded by Alfred B. Ford. Visit the temple and bazar. BLD

Wednesday, October 15	Chandernagore	Ganges Voyager	This morning cruise to Chandernagore a French colony established in 1673 as a trading post. A heritage walk includes a museum with French antiques, and memorabilia depicting life from this period. Also visit the Sacred Heart Church built by a French architect in 1884. This evening, celebrate with a farewell dinner and cultural program. BLD
