July 20 Independent arrivals in Juneau*

July 22 Haines*

Haines combines historic significance with an eclectic spirit. Don't miss Fort William H. Seaward, a National Historic Landmark and a former key outpost of the U.S. Army and the quirky Hammer Museum. Choose an optional wildlife excursion or visit the many artisan workshops downtown. Cap it off with libations at the Port Chillkoot Distillery. (B, L, D)

July 23 Glacier Bay

Few sites are as stunning as majestic Glacier Bay National Park, which comprises more than three million acres of unspoiled natural beauty. Spot native wildlife and learn more from onboard specialists who provide in-depth knowledge of the area's ecological and geological marvels. (B, L, D)

July 24 Petersburg*

Designed with comfort in mind, *American Constitution* can host up to 170 guests. Each


cabin is equipped with a private balcony and

putting green, fitness center and onboard entertainment and activities. All decks are


