





# Lower Mississippi River Cruise: New Orleans to Memphis

### MAR. 25 New Orleans/Embarkation

#### MAR. 28 Baton Rouge, LA\*

Melding Cajun and Creole influences, Baton Rouge's rich past is evident in its diverse architecture. See the impressive Art Deco Louisiana State Capitol building, an iconic political and historic landmark. (B, L, D)

#### MAR. 29 Natchez, MS\*

Engage in captivating enrichment sessions and lively onboard events. (B, L, D)


#### APR. 1 Memphis, TN\*

Our program concludes this morning in Memphis. (B)


