Bask in the comfort of having a smaller guest-guide ratio, allowing excursion groups to stay well below the National Park maximum of 16:1.

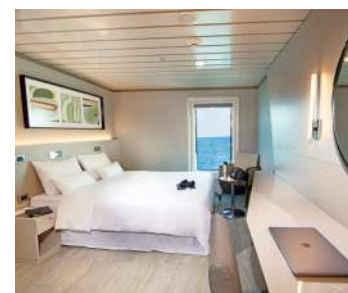

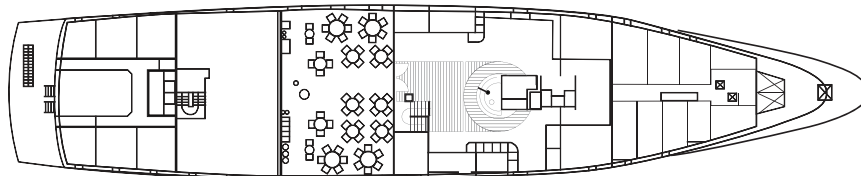
Sun Deck
