**Day 1 | October 27**

Depart your home city.

Day 2 | October 28 **D**

Embark | Porto, Portugal

Arrive in Porto and transfer to the *Porto Mirante*. Spend the afternoon exploring at your leisure; then gather for dinner.

Day 3 | October 29 **B-L-R-D**

Porto

Join a guided tour of Porto's historic quarter, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. See the Porto Cathedral, one of the city's oldest monuments, and Liberty Square, the town's central plaza that connects the historic and modern parts of the city. The plaza is ringed with inviting shops and cafés. Witness the São Bento Railway Station, a beautiful station filled with incredible azulejos — distinctive blue-and-white, hand-painted tiles. This afternoon, indulge in a port tasting. You will have a choice on how you arrive at the traditional wine estate — by motorcoach or a scenic hike.

Day 4 | October 30 **B-L-D**

Porto | Cruising the Douro River Valley | Peso da Régua

As the boat gently winds its way along the river's path, steep terraced vineyards rise on either side, carved into the hillsides by generations of winemakers. Rolling hills dotted with olive groves, whitewashed quintas and charming stone villages create a patchwork of rustic beauty. In autumn, the valley glows with hues of gold and crimson as the vines turn with the season.

Day 5 | October 31 **B-L-D**

Peso da Régua | Lamego | Pinhão

After breakfast, venture out for your chosen excursion to Lamego. Visit this ancient

and picturesque town on foot or by motorcoach. Lamego is home to one of the Nossa Senhora dos Remédios, an important pilgrimage site set on a spectacular hilltop. The church is accessed by a double staircase of 686 steps and nine terraces, decorated with statues and azulejos.

This afternoon, visit the Pinhão Railway Station, famous for its lovely azulejos that depict scenes of local significance — winemakers, folk culture and local landscapes.

Day 6 | November 1 **B-L-D**

Pinhão | Vila Real

Step into a world of artistry, heritage and timeless beauty at the enchanting Palácio de

Next, enjoy an authentic dining experience. From fresh seafood to hearty regional dishes, Portuguese cuisine offers a true taste of the country's cultural heritage.

Day 7 | November 2 B-L-D

Pinhão |
Vega de Terrón, Spain
Spend time soaking up the beautiful scenery while sailing from Pinhão to Vega de Terrón, an alluring

riverside village in western Spain near the Portuguese border. Upon arrival, disembark for a local food tasting experience.

Day 8 | November 3 B-L-R-D

Vega de Terrón
Travel by coach to the enchanting hilltop village of Castelo Rodrigo, a fortified settlement steeped in history and surrounded by ancient walls dating back to 1296. Upon arrival, set out on a guided walking tour through its narrow, cobbled streets, where time seems to stand still. Discover the village's fascinating past, from its strategic importance during medieval conflicts to its well-preserved architectural

heritage. Wander past centuries-old stone houses with red-tiled roofs and visit historic landmarks like the old cistern and medieval church.

Gather for a Farewell Reception this evening.

Day 9 | November 4 B-L

Vega de Terrón |
Disembark | Salamanca |
Madrid

Disembark and travel to Salamanca for an excursion. This vibrant city is known as a nucleus of education, culture and art, and the city's historic center is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Called Spain's "Golden City," Salamanca is

filled with historic buildings in a mix of architectural styles, many of which are made of gold-colored sandstone.

Enjoy a traditional Spanish lunch at a local restaurant.

Continue to Madrid and check into the *InterContinental Madrid*. You are then free to enjoy dinner on your own this evening and begin exploring Madrid!

Day 10 | November 5 **B-R**

Madrid

Set off to explore the wonders of Madrid today. An insightful tour reveals Madrid's elegant, tree-lined boulevards; large, landscaped parks; architecture and lovely fountains. Stop in to the Prado Museum, which boasts one of the world's finest collections of European art, renowned for its superior

collection of artworks by Goya, El Greco and Rubens, among others.

Tonight, raise a toast during a Farewell Reception.

Madrid | Return to Home City

Following breakfast, transfer to the airport for your return flight home.

Prime Port Wine

The Douro River Valley is famous for producing many varieties of wine and, more famously, for the distinctive fortified wine called port, which cannot be produced anywhere else in the world. This region's unique topography and geography, and the number of microclimates along the twisting Douro River, are responsible for the diverse variety of delicious grapes that can grow here...and, consequently, the number of different wines that can be produced.

Port, a local specialty loved the world over, is made of a blend of up to 40 kinds of grapes. The grapes are picked by hand (machines can't harvest as well as humans) and are usually crushed by foot (machines tend to break the seeds, releasing too much tannin and a bitter flavor). The stomping takes place in granite vats called lagares, which then drain into fermentation tanks made of cement or steel. However, the fermentation process is halted before completion by the addition of brandy (usually imported from South Africa). This stabilizes the port for long-term aging and creates a distinctive dry sweetness that truly enjoy.
