

# CIRCUMNAVIGATING THE EMERALD ISLE Ireland aboard the 72-stateroom *Exploris One* May 20–30, 2026 (10 days)

This new spring itinerary features an eight-night private charter of the *Exploris One* as she circles Ireland, starting in Belfast and ending in Dublin. Criterion includes a pre-cruise hotel night to ensure all arrive in time to embark and to allow for Dublin excursions customized to lecturer preferences. Cruising the entire Emerald Isle, this itinerary includes remote and legendary sites of Ireland's "Wild Atlantic Way," as well as UNESCO protected ancient sites, lush gardens, sea-swept islands, and charming towns. Travelers enjoy a perfect combination of small scenic harbors, cosmopolitan cities, and spectacular coastal landscapes. In addition, at nearly every port of call, there will be a choice of shore excursions, usually with one excursion following a castle & garden theme and the other featuring an archaeological/historical site. The variety of these excursions are combined with a relaxed pace, a robust lecture program, free time for independent exploration, and options for meals ashore in Belfast, Galway, and Kinsale.

- Marvel at the beauty of **Ireland's celebrated gardens** including Powerscourt (considered top 3 garden in the world); the Mount Stewart Home and Gardens of the Londonderry family near Belfast, the charming Salthill Gardens of County Donegal, and Kylemore Abbey with its beautiful Victorian walled garden, located in the heart of Connemara National Park.
- Dig deep into Ireland's **rich archaeological heritage** with visits to Dublin's National Museum of Archaeology, the 5,000-year-old tombs at Newgrange, the 3,000-year-old stone fort of Dun Aonghusa on the Aran Islands and the UNESCO Skellig Michael, ruins of an early Christian monastery.
- Experience the jewels of Ireland's famed Atlantic Coast including the dramatic **Cliffs of Moher** and the stunning mountains, and the bogs and grasslands of **Connemara National Park.**
- **Dock overnight in Belfast and Galway** for a chance to dine ashore and/or enjoy their lively atmosphere and famed music scene.
- Discover **Belfast's intriguing history** including a visit to Titanic Belfast, a state-of-the-art museum on the site of the yard where the ill-fated ship was built.
- Travel along the Northern Ireland's Antrim coast to the **World Heritage-listed Giants Causeway**, the site of some 40,000 hexagonal basalt column

## EXPLORIS ONE

Previously known as the *Silver Explorer* and owned by Silversea Cruises, *Exploris One* began her new life with the French company Exploris Expeditions in 2023. Having known this vessel for many years, we know her to be ideal for small ship cruising; for our exclusive charter, we will be accommodating just 120 guests on board, including staff. The vessel's shallow draft will allow us to navigate in areas that larger ships would not be able to access and whilst cruising, the vessel benefits from spacious deck areas from where you can watch for passing wildlife and admire the beautiful scenery.

*Exploris One*, renovated in 2023, combines adventure and an exceptional level of comfort. The 60 staterooms and 12 suites are all outside and finished to high standards. Equipped with 12 zodiacs, all passengers disembark to explore the region at one time. Le Grand Restaurant and the Outdoor Grill offer refined French and International cuisine. The Grand Salon and Panoramic Lounge provide opportunities for breathtaking views. Additional onboard amenities include a dedicated conference room for lectures, hair salon, fitness center, massage room, sauna, and two hot tubs.
