### Day 3 | June 13 B-L-R-D

Dubrovnik

After a filling breakfast, disembark for a walking tour of UNESCO-inscribed Dubrovnik. Enter the city gate to see the Large Onofrio's Fountain, designed in 1438. Admire the neighboring façade of St. Savior Church and visit the 14th-century Romanesque Franciscan Church and Monastery, a masterpiece of architecture. The large complex comprises a friary, church, library and a historical pharmacy museum.

Venture out on a Traveler's Choice excursion. You may choose to walk around the city's medieval ramparts, an experience that offers splendid views of Dubrovnik's distinctive orange rooftops, the harbor and a stretch of blue sea beyond. Alternatively, visit the Rector's Palace and Maritime Museum. Return to enjoy lunch on the ship.

Later, join your fellow travelers for a Captain's Welcome Reception and dinner.

### Day 4 | June 14

Tivat, Montenegro | Kotor The Balkan country of Montenegro greets you this morning. Disembark in Tivat for an excursion to UNESCO-listed Kotor. Take a guided walk through these storied streets and squares. Step into the impressive Cathedral of Saint Tryphon to witness the ornate vaulted roof and pillars made of pink stone. Next, enjoy a Traveler's Choice excursion. You can choose to cruise to Our Lady of the Rocks island for a tour or relax for an afternoon at the beach.





Return to the ship for dinner and depart for Italy's coast.

### Day 5 | June 15 B-L-D

Bari, Italy | Alberobello Discover the wonders of Bari! This ancient seaport boasts a tight tangle of medieval streets and a pretty harbor with colorful bobbing boats. Take a walking tour of the old town, noting the carved Apulian-Romanesque portal of the 11th-century Basilica di San Nicola. Pass by historic churches, fishermen selling their catch and beautiful architecture along the path.

After lunch, continue to dazzling Alberobello, home to the largest concentration of mysterious trulli. Found nowhere else in the world, these whitewashed limestone structures are pieced together without mortar, and their pointed fieldstone roofs are



often painted with primitive Christian and pagan symbols.

Enjoy panoramic views as the ship departs Bari for a cruise to Croatia.

### Day 6 | June 16

Hvar, Croatia

Sunny Hvar is a Croatian favorite lauded for its lavender plantations, olive grove and inviting Mediterranean ambience. With a history that dates back to 6,000 B.C., the island simply brims with cultural and historical heritage that delights all who visit.

Today's Traveler's Choice options include a guided walking tour of the old town with a stop at a Benedictine Monastery to watch the delicate, labor-intensive practice of making lace. If you're feeling active, stretch your legs on a hike up to Hvar's Fortica, which is called Spanjola by locals. Return to the ship for dinner.

### Day 7 | June 17 B-L-D

Trogir | Split

Disembark in Trogir for a thought-provoking excursion to Split. Experience the sights and sounds of this ancient imperial city while visiting the spectacular UNESCO World Heritage-inscribed Diocletian's Palace, which has been continuously inhabited since the Roman emperor abdicated his throne in A.D. 305. Roaming this complex's tangle of passageways, courtyards and underground chambers is an enchanting adventure. Next. visit the Cathedral of Saint Domnius, the patron saint of Split,

and the Temple of Jupiter. Today's excursion also includes exterior visits to the Golden Gate, Silver Gate and Peristyle Square.

### Day 8 | June 18

Ravenna, Italy

Greet the day in charming Ravenna, the city of mosaics. Disembark to enjoy a Traveler's Choice excursion. Stay in Ravenna to see intricate UNESCO-inscribed mosaics at the Basilica of San Vitale and the Galle Placidia Mausoleum. Or, choose to spend a day in neighboring Bologna, the epicenter of the Emilia-Romagna region with extensive porticoes and a hilltop monastery.

### Day 9 | June 19 B-L-R-D Rovinj, Croatia

Romantic Rovinj is perched along the Istrian Peninsula. Today's Traveler's Choices include visiting Pula, a nearby coastal town with an elliptical Roman amphitheater and a refreshing ambience. Your other option is a walking tour of Rovinj's enchanting old town filled with multicolored buildings, hidden alleyways perfect for photographing

He directs the American Institute for Roman Culture and its online learning platform, Ancient Rome Live.

He has been an expert for The Great Courses and has hosted or appeared on programs on the History Channel, National Geographic, Discovery, Smithsonian, PBS, Italy's Rai5 and more.
