

UNESCO TREASURES OF ANCIENT GREECE Circumnavigating the Peloponnese by Private Luxury Yacht aboard the 50-Cabin *Emerald Azzurra* September 17–26, 2026 (10 days)

We pleased to be returning to Greece's Peloponnese, this time aboard the 50-Cabin luxury megayacht *Emerald Azzurra*, an identical twin to the *Emerald Sakara* Criterion. This program begins with an overnight in historic Athens on Syntagma Square and a rooftop welcome overlooking the Acropolis. Following a morning of optional activities (customized by the lecture team) and a sumptuous Greek lunch at one of Athens' top restaurants, travelers embark the *Emerald Azzurra* in Piraeus for a 7-night private charter. The ship's intimate size and speed allows access to smaller harbors, unhurried excursions ashore, and a circumnavigation of the Peloponnese culminating with a transit of the Corinth Canal back to Athens. And should you wish to explore Athens further, a twonight optional pre-tour extension is available.

As the "cradle of Western civilization," Greece and the Peloponnese Peninsula offer an ideal blend of history, diverse cultural legacies, stunning natural beauty, and a most impressive collection of World Heritage Sites. On this itinerary, five UNESCO treasures of antiquity await with stops at Mycenae, whose impressive ruins once concealed the mask of Agamemnon; the spectacular theater at Epidaurus; the fortified Byzantine settlement of Mystras; ancient Olympia, site of the original Olympic Games, and the Oracle of Delphi, the most important shrine in ancient Greece. Beyond these marvels, Criterion has incorporated time for a special access visit to Nestor's Palace, best preserved Bronze Age palace, a cruise through the Diros Caves, free time in the beautiful seaside towns of Nafplion, Gythio, and Pylos; convenient times for lectures; and ample opportunities to enjoy the ship's amenities.

- Visit five UNESCO World Heritage sites with expert local guides: Epidaurus, Mycenae, Mystras, Olympia, and Delphi.
- **Transit of the Corinth Canal**, whose history extends back into classical times, including an unsuccessful attempt to build it in the 1st century AD.
- **Cruise for seven nights aboard the luxurious, state-of-the-art** *Emerald Azzurra*, a privately chartered mega-yacht built, appointed, and staffed at the highest levels of comfort and service.
- Gain special access to the most important Mycenaean archaeological sites in Greece, including Nestor's Palace dating back before 1200 BCE.
- **Explore beautiful seaside towns of Nafplion, Gythio and Pylos** boasting cobblestone streets, white-washed facades, and colorful harbors dotted with cafes.

ABOUT EMERALD AZZURRA



Sept 19 Sat	Athens/ Piraeus	Emerald Azzurra -1	First lecture after breakfast; AM visit to private Goulandris Museum of Cycladic Art or Benaki Museum of Greek Culture; beautiful views over Greek lunch at Dionysos Zonars; embark ship in Piraeus; Captain's welcome reception and dinner this evening. Sept 20 Sun	Nafplion	Emerald Azzurra -2	Full day visit to UNESCO sites of Mycenae , where Schliemann unearthed the reputed mask of Agamemnon and Epidaurus with <i>asclepeion</i> and marvelous acoustics of 4 th c. theater; PM walking tour and free time in colorful seaport town of Nafplion beneath the Venetian Palamidi castle. Sept 21 Mon	Gythion	Emerald Azzurra -3	Morning lecture; AM visits to UNESCO site of Mystras , well preserved medieval walled town, and legendary Sparta; PM cruise in small boats through stalagmites and stalactites in Diros Caves , centuries-old shelter and place of worship. BD
Sept 22 Tue	Kalamata	Emerald Azzurra -4	Morning lecture; AM visit UNESCO site of ancient Messene , classical city-state re-founded in 369 BC, with ongoing excavations and restoration projects and an onsite museum displaying their finds; PM cruising and swimming. BD
Sept 23 Wed	Pylos	Emerald Azzurra -5	Full day in Pylos ; special behind-the-scenes morning visit to Nestor's Palace , best preserved Bronze Age palace on Greek mainland; PM visit to Methoni Castle , among the largest Mediterranean or Pylos Archeological Museum; free time to explore Pylos' picturesque historic center . BLD
Sept 24 Thu	Katakalon/ Olympia	Emerald Azzurra -6	Morning visit to UNESCO site of Olympia , iconic site of the ancient Olympic Games, with temples, stadium, sanctuary, stoa, and museum; partake in a foot race on the Olympic Track; PM cruising the Gulf of Corinth. BLD
Sept 25 Fri	Itea (Delphi)/ Corinth Canal	Emerald Azzurra -7	Morning lecture; AM dock at Itea and climb to UNESCO ruins of Delphi , where the Oracle's pronouncements were sought for centuries; PM cruise through dramatic Corinth Canal ; Captain's farewell reception and dinner on board. BLD
