A World of Discovery

AHI Connects | Beekeeping. At a bee farm, learn about Slovenia's thriving api-tourism industry and taste honey.

Slovenia's Capital. Uncover the sites of Ljubljana, a bounty of Renaissance and baroque architecture. Browse the bustling Central Market and visit Prešeren Square. bordered by the Franciscan Church of the Annunciation. Walk through Congress Square, see the University of Ljubljana and step inside the Ljubljana Cathedral. Cruise on Ljubljanica River, bordered with weeping willows, and skim under legendary bridges.

Lake Bled & Bled Castle. This pristine setting boasts mountains, a swan-filled lake and a fairytale castle. Ride aboard a pletna, a flat-bottomed boat, to Bled Island, home to the Church of the Assumption of Mary and a fabled 16th-century wishing bell. Then marvel at sweeping vistas of the lake from above at the cliff-top Bled Castle.

Northeastern Slovenia. Journey through sunny hills and meadows to Ptui, Slovenia's oldest town. Continue to Maribor to see The Old Vine, which first produced grapes in the 17th century, and Maribor Cathedral. Cap off the excursion with a visit to a local winery and settle in for a tasting and lunch.

Postojna Cave & Predjama Castle.

At Postojna Cave, ride a mini-train into an expansive cavern, passing stalactite and rock formations. Witness Predjama Castle, a fortress built under a cliff.

Piran. Succumb to the allure of the Adriatic coast in the fishing village of Piran. During a walking tour, discover Piran's Venetian-style architecture, and view Gabrielli Palace, the Church of St. George and Tartini Square, named after violinist Giorgio Tartini.

Pula & Romantic Rovinj. Explore two favorite destinations of the Istrian peninsula. In Pula, view the iconic and well-preserved Roman theater and other attractions. Tour the enchanting old town of Rovini, passing rainbow buildings, narrow streets and the baroque St. Euphemia's Basilica.

Motovun & Grožnjan. Head into the hinterlands for a visit to medieval Motovun, perched on a hill overlooking the Mirna River. After a walking tour through the narrow streets, enjoy lunch featuring Istrian gold, the truffle. The Istrian peninsula has some of the richest truffle deposits found in the world. Taste the special flavors of this treasure. Next, venture on to Grožnjan, known in Istria as an artists' village. The historic old town is filled with art galleries, film schools, typical Croatian restaurants and fanciful boutiques.
