Aboard *Exploris One*, custom-designed for polar waters, accompany naturalist guides and expert lecturers to see icebergs up close via Zodiac excursions and explore geological wonders and glaciers unseen elsewhere on Earth. Meet residents of Inuit settlements for insights into local culture. In private island sanctuaries, observe Arctic animals like polar bears, musk oxen, and colonies of puffins in their natural habitats. Join us for this unforgettable adventure featuring a rare astronomical spectacle!

The recently renovated *Exploris One* (formerly Silversea Cruise Line's *Silver Explorer*) was specially designed to sail the world's most demanding waters in the polar regions. Equipped with a reinforced hull, *Exploris One* is a global benchmark for exploring glacial regions in a completely safe environment. Enjoy an exceptional level of comfort, along with personalized service.

The ship features 60 cabins and 12 suites, among the most spacious available on expedition ships. Enjoy a fitness and well-being area, panoramic decks and lounges, and outdoor Jacuzzis for a moment of relaxation with a view. Onboard Zodiacs allow passengers to disembark all together several times a day, depending on the navigation conditions, in areas that are usually inaccessible.


