Through his work with endangered species as a biologist, Rodney came to believe that rather than locking wilderness areas away, it was important to share them with people, who might then become ambassadors, advocating for and supporting conservation efforts. Heritage has long held the view that conservation and responsible travel are partners, together achieving what might otherwise be unachievable.

Today Heritage Expeditions is still family-owned and run. Each authentic, small-ship expedition cruise is meticulously planned and led, ensuring guests learn and experience as much as possible about the region, while at the same time minimizing the ecological impact of their visit.


