

Itinerary

Day 1 Toronto, ON/ Midland, ON/Embarkation

Individual arrivals in Toronto. Transfer independently to Midland for early embarkation aboard *Pearl Mist*. (L, R, D)

Day 2 Parry Sound, ON\*

Picturesque Parry Sound is a maritime village comprised of rugged shorelines and a unique ecosystem recognized by the United Nations as a World Biosphere Reserve. (B, L, D)

Day 3 Little Current, ON\*

Charming Little Current is considered the gateway to the World's Largest Freshwater Island. Its historic swing bridge affords the only vehicular access to Manitoulin Island. (B, L, D)

Day 4 Sault Sainte Marie, ON\*

Established by Jesuit missionaries in the 17th century, Sault Sainte Marie was a crucial trade hub between the United States and Canada and melds native Ojibwa, French, and English influences. (B, L, D)

Enjoy a Milwaukee exploration, traveling through historic neighborhoods and popular attractions. (B, L, D)


Day 8 Milwaukee, WI/Disembark
