## **Marco Island Historical Museum**

Long famous for its Key Marco Cat, one of the most remarkable and influential discoveries in North American archaeology. Marco Island Historical Museum explores Southwest Florida's Calusa Indians and brings this vanished civilization to life with informative displays and an exciting, recreated village scene. Permanent and traveling exhibits trace the settlement of this subtropical island paradise from its early pioneer roots as a fishing village, pineapple plantation, and clam cannery, through its explosive growth and development in the 1960s by the Miami-based Deltona Corporation.





## **Dolphin Explorer**

Discover the subtropical estuaries and bays surrounding Marco Island, the largest mangrove forest in the western hemisphere of the world and home to a population of resident dolphins. On this narrated cruise, learn how to identify these marine mammals and get to know them by name. Take photographs of dolphins as well as local and migratory birds enjoying their natural habitat. Stop to explore and collect shells on the nearby barrier beaches





#### The Everglades & 10,000 Islands

Experience this natural wonder, perfect for wildlife enthusiasts and those eager to discover the unique beauty of Florida's coastal wilderness. Aboard a covered Pontoon, navigate the serene Faka Union Canal and explore the breathtaking 10,000 Islands, a haven for diverse wildlife like manatees, dolphins, alligators, and numerous bird species. Knowledgeable guides will enrich your journey with insights into the ecosystem and local history.

Peruse The Harry Goulding Memorial Hibiscus Garden, featuring over a 100 varieties of Hibiscus created by this Punta Gorda native and nationally renowned hybridizer. Interact with local docents in period dress who share the history captured in the park. Plein air artists, who come to the park for inspiration, and local musicians all add to the ambiance of the experience. Don't miss the "Calaboose" for a great photo op – it served as Punta Gorda's jail from 1889 – 1928.





#### **Peace River Wildlife Center**

Explore this rehabilitation center tucked neatly away into the mangroves overlooking Charlotte Harbor at Ponce de Leon Park. With close to 60 wildlife residents, the center serves native Florida wildlife through rescue, rehabilitation, and education.



## Fishermen's Village

Just a short distance from the ship, stroll through this picturesque village featuring more than 30 independently owned shops, boutiques, and eateries. Shop for one-of-a-kind gifts and souvenirs, relax with a cold beverage at the Sunset Beach Club Tiki Bar, or grab a sweet treat of candy or ice cream.



### **Visual Arts Center**

This hub for creativity and artistic expression, walking distance from the ship, offers a variety of art classes and workshops for all ages. The center also hosts rotating art exhibitions featuring local and regional artists. Admire original works created in a variety of mediums. Featured are three major galleries, six classrooms; jewelry, glass, pottery, and fiber studios; an extensive arts library, and Gift Gallery.





## **Tampa Bay Watch Eco Cruise**


