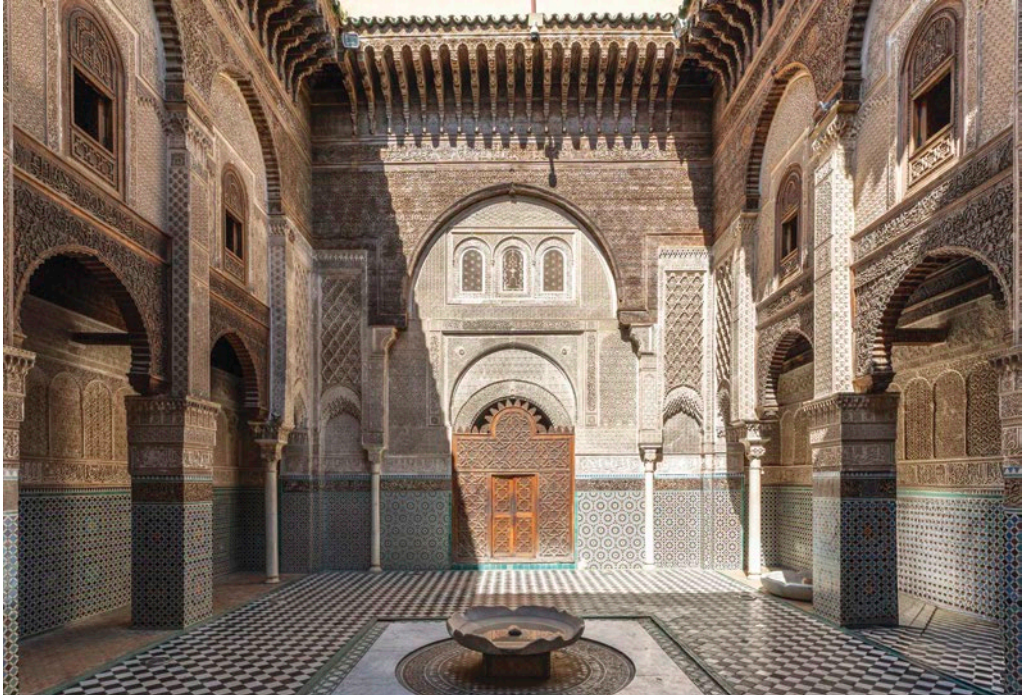

### Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Casablanca, Morocco. 🌐

### Day 2 | Casablanca, Morocco | Rabat

Upon arrival, transfer 🔄 to Rabat and check in to the hotel.

Join your fellow travelers for a Welcome Reception and Dinner this evening.

### Day 3 | Rabat

**Enrichment: Moroccan History.** Learn about the country's fascinating history, from the Berber dynasty to modern-day Morocco.

**Rabat Walking Tour.** View the breathtaking architecture of the Royal Palace, the residence of Morocco's royalty. Next, stroll the streets of Kasbah des Oudayas, a peaceful neighborhood with whitewashed houses. Continue to the striking Mausoleum of Mohammad V, the resting place of past kings, and gaze in wonder at the majestic Hassan Tower, rising above the ruins of its mosque. Cap off today's excursion at the Citadel of Chellah, which has been abandoned since the 1100s.

### Day 4 | Meknes | Volubilis | Fes

**Meknes & Volubilis.** Travel to Meknes, home to a beautifully preserved royal palace and the stunning Bab Mansour, a monumental gateway to the Medina overlooking El Hedim Square. Continue to a local winery for a vineyard tour and a special tasting, followed by lunch.

Next, uncover the remarkable ruins of Volubilis, Morocco's largest Roman archaeological site.

### Day 5 | Fes

**Fes.** Explore this diverse city shaped by more than 12 centuries of history and tradition. Begin in Fes el-Bali, the ninth-century district within the medina, where narrow alleyways wind through lively souks, artisan workshops, spice stalls, and the city's iconic tanneries. Admire the Nejjarine Fountain, carved from cedarwood and adorned with zellij tilework, and see the Quaraouiyin Mosque, the world's oldest university, before entering the spiritual Al Attarine Madrasa.

Savor a Moroccan lunch at a local restaurant, then continue to Fes Jdid, known as "New Fes," to explore the historic Mellah, the former Jewish district, and view the impressive Royal Palace. Cap off the day with breathtaking panoramic views across the entire medina.

### Day 6 | Fes | Casablanca | Marrakech

**Casablanca Discovery.** Experience the vibrant atmosphere of Casablanca's central square, Place Mohammad V. As Morocco's largest city, Casablanca combines contemporary life with centuries of cultural heritage. The square is lined with striking Mauresque architecture. Pause to admire the façade of the Church of the Sacred Heart. Then, visit the state-of-the-art Hassan II Mosque, beautifully nestled on Casablanca's coastline. The mosque is one of the largest places of worship on Earth!



Settle in for a memorable lunch before continuing your journey to Marrakech.

### Day 7 | Marrakech

**Enrichment: Moroccan Culture.** Learn how Arab, European and African influences created Morocco's captivating culture.

**Monuments of Marrakech.** Begin today's tour at the Ben Youssef Medersa, a 14th-century icon of Andalusian-Arabic architecture. Continue to Souk Semmarine, where colorful alleys invite you to browse local handicrafts. Visit the Bahia Palais, the "Palace of Brilliance," known for its luxurious apartments, courtyards, zellige mosaic floors and lush gardens. Stop for a delightful Moroccan lunch of authentic flavors. Early this evening, admire the iconic Koutoubia Mosque minaret and experience the vibrant heart of Marrakech's medina, Jemaa el-Fnaa. This legendary square comes alive with fire-eaters, performers, storytellers, and musicians. Take in the action from a rooftop café, then join your guide to stroll the bustling square.

Enjoy a dinner of tantalizing Moroccan cuisine.

### Day 8 | Marrakech

**Cooking & Calligraphy.** Visit the Amal Targa Center, a nonprofit helping disadvantaged women develop cooking skills, gain roles in the hospitality industry and prepare for financial independence. Learn to prepare traditional Moroccan dishes, including salads, bread, tagine and dessert. While your lunch is cooking, enjoy a lesson in Arabic calligraphy, practicing the beautiful patterns, lines, and curves.

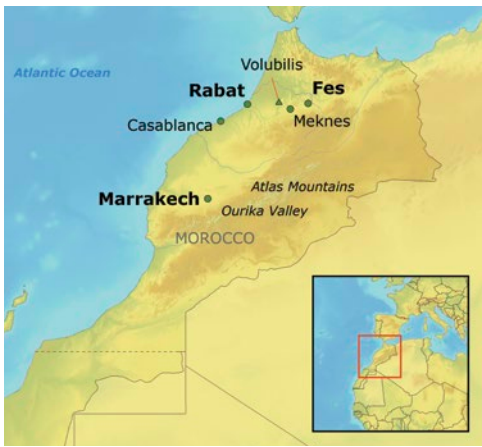
**Free Time:** Spend an afternoon at leisure exploring beautiful Marrakech.

### Day 9 | Atlas Mountains | Ourika Valley

**Atlas Mountains.** Journey through dramatic landscapes deep within North Africa's highest mountain range. Take in breathtaking vistas of the Atlas Mountains from the impressive ANIMA Garden, where panoramic views are complemented by the art of André Heller. Continue through the serene Ourika Valley,

**Day 10 | Marrakech**

**Gardens & Souks.** Discover Jardin Majorelle, an oasis of fountains, flora and vivid cobalt architecture created in the 1920s by French artist Jacques Majorelle and later restored by Yves Saint Laurent and his partner Pierre Bergé. Visit the Yves Saint Laurent Museum, featuring the designer's haute couture and a library. Return to the buzzing souks for a tour with tastings of local products and insights into the spices and herbs used in traditional meals.

**Free Time:** Discover more of Marrakech at your own pace.

Bid farewell to your Moroccan adventure during a Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant.

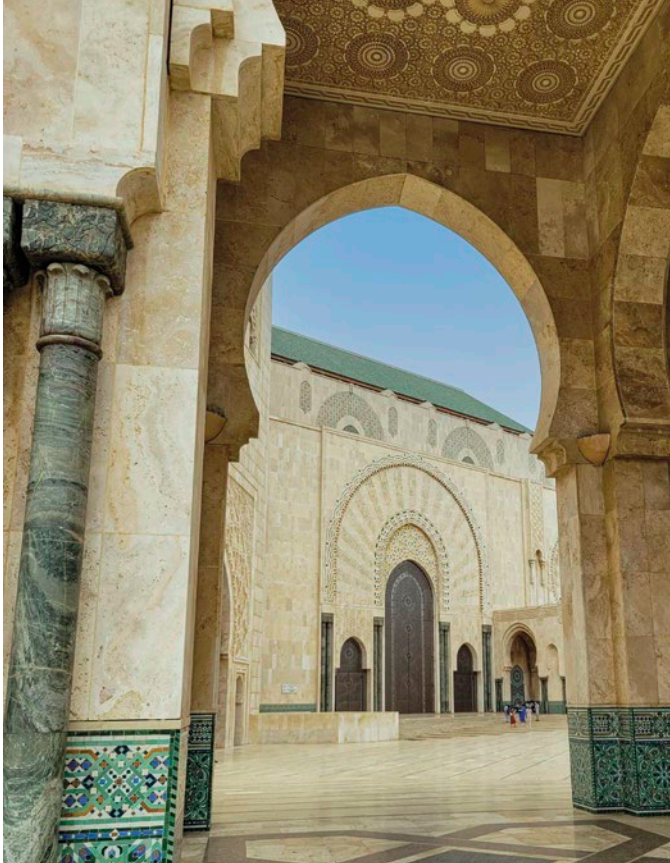

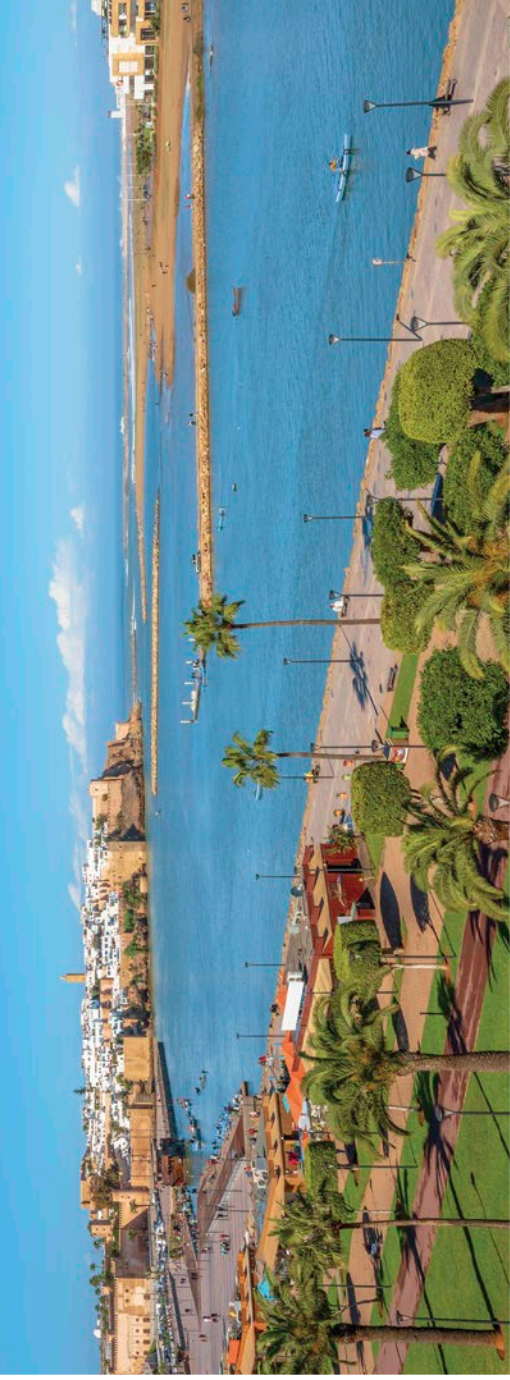
