Land of the Rising Sun: Kanazawa to Kobe Aboard the 59-Cabin *Island Sky*

April 10–20, 2027
(11 days)

For 2027, Criterion has secured an **8-night Japan charter** aboard the 59-cabin *Island Sky* in April, the height of springtime—when cherry blossoms and fresh greenery enhance temples, shrines, gardens, and castles. Excursions reveal Japan’s rich traditions alongside its modern achievements, design innovations, and culinary delights. To avoid crowds and keep a relaxed pace, the journey begins in **Kanazawa**, a tranquil and artistic city seldom visited by travelers. At each port, options include sacred temples, celebrated gardens, contemporary sites, and hands-on cultural activities.

The all-suite *Island Sky* offers sea views in every generously sized cabin, marble-appointed bathrooms, a dining room, two lounges, library, observation deck, and elevator service. International cuisine is served at a single seating, complemented by service from a crew-to-passenger ratio better than 1:2.

Enhance your trip with a **2-night pre-extension** to Tokyo—or a **3-night post-extension** to Nara and Kyoto.

- Customize your experience according to your interests with a menu of excursion options throughout, beginning with UNESCO World Heritage Site **Shirikawa-go’s thatched homes** or **Yamanaka Onsen**, made famous by haiku poet Basho.
- Immerse in the culture during a traditional **tea ceremony** in Kanazawa or a hands-on workshop making **wagashi Japanese sweets**.
- Explore two incredible castles - **Matsue Castle** has the second largest, original wooden keep in Japan and **Kokura Castle** is the only castle in Fukuoka Prefecture with a main keep.
- Meet celebrated author **Pico Iyer** during a private lecture on **Naoshima**, an island **mecca for cutting-edge art**.
- Spend a **day in South Korea** featuring a visit to **Gyeongju**, the ancient capital of the Silla kingdom and a UNESCO World Cultural Site.
- Marvel at **Itsukushima Shrine** in Miyajima with its iconic red torii, a grand wooden gateway that appears to float on the sea at high tide.
- Walk along the paths of **Kenroku-en Garden**, one of Japan’s top three gardens, and **Ritsurin Garden**, the largest Cultural Property Garden in all of Japan.
- Visit **Nagasaki’s Dejima**, the only artificial island allowed to interact with other countries during the national isolation period of the Edo period, a nationally designated historic site representing Nagasaki.
- **Savor the flavors of East Asia** including fresh sushi in Kanazawa, BBQ in South Korea, and Champon noodles in Nagasaki, each meal offering a taste of local culture.
