Depart your home city for Venice, Italy.

Day 2 | September 5

Venice, Italy | Embark

Arrive in Venice and embark the deluxe *World Traveller*.

Say hello to fellow travelers over dinner aboard the ship.

Day 3 | September 6 B-L-R-D

Split, Croatia

After a morning at sea and lunch on board, arrive in Split, Croatia, where layers of ancient history blend with the character of the modern city. Join a guided tour of UNESCO World Heritage-inscribed Diocletian's Palace, including its remarkably preserved cellars, the Cathedral of Saint Domnius and the Temple of Jupiter. See the Golden Gate, Silver Gate and Peristyle Square before enjoying free time to explore the town at your own pace. Split is known for its relaxed café culture. Sample a refreshing Aperol Spritz or local Dalmatian wines while people-watching.

Shop for local specialties, such as Croatian olive oil, hand-made jewelry and neckties (the cravat originated in Croatia).

Enjoy a Welcome Reception.

Day 4 | September 7 B-L-D

Hvar

Discover Hvar island, an Adriatic jewel shaped by centuries of Greek, Roman, Byzantine and Venetian influence. Explore the charming Old Town on a guided walking tour featuring St. Stephen's Cathedral, the Benedictine Monastery and its renowned UNESCO-recognized agave lace tradition. This tradition dates to the 19th century and is practiced exclusively

by the Benedictine nuns.

They harvest fresh agave leaves, carefully pull out the silky fibers by hand and allow them to dry before twisting them into thread. They then create intricate lace patterns entirely by hand — a process that can take weeks or even months for a single piece.

Next, choose between a visit to a vineyard to taste Hvar's celebrated wines or a relaxing afternoon at a beach club.

Day 5 | September 8 B-L-D

Dubrovnik

Explore Dubrovnik, the "Pearl of the Adriatic," on a guided walking tour through its UNESCO World Heritage-

listed Old Town. Enclosed by impressive medieval walls, this beautifully preserved city showcases centuries of maritime wealth through its grand squares, monasteries, churches and Renaissance architecture. See landmarks including Onofrio's Fountain, St. Savior Church and the Franciscan Church and Monastery, home to one of Europe's oldest pharmacies. Next, visit the historic Rector's Palace and Maritime Museum, exploring the palace and discovering the rich maritime history that

helped shape Dubrovnik's enduring legacy.

As the ship sails this afternoon, admire the spectacular Adriatic coastline before enjoying an evening of traditional klapa music.

Day 6 | September 9 B-L-D
Kotor, Montenegro

Wake to scenic cruising before arriving in the spectacular Bay of Kotor, Montenegro, one of the Adriatic's most dramatic natural harbors. Explore the UNESCO World Heritage-listed medieval town of Kotor on a guided walking tour, including the Romanesque Cathedral of Saint Tryphon.

Return to the ship for lunch aboard and relax on deck as the ship sails through the breathtaking bay, where soaring limestone peaks, picturesque villages and historic churches create unforgettable views.

Day 7 | September 10 B-L-D
Corfu, Greece

Arrive in Corfu midday and enjoy lunch on board before exploring this beautiful Greek island, renowned for its Venetian architecture and rich history. Begin with a guided walking tour through its UNESCO World Heritage-listed Old Town, passing

historic landmarks that reflect the island's centuries of Venetian, French and British influence. Next, enjoy free time to enjoy a Greek coffee, gelato or glass of local wine beneath the elegant arcades overlooking one of Greece's largest town squares.

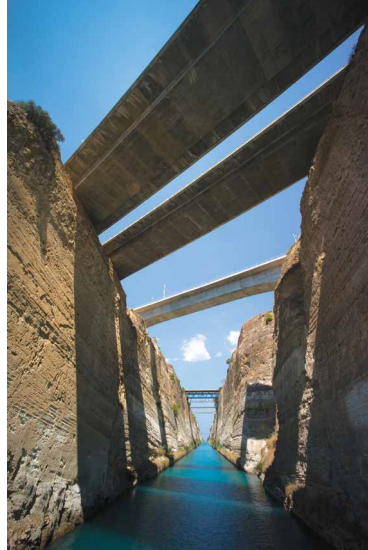
Return to the ship for dinner.

Day 8 | September 11 B-L-R-D

Itea | Delphi |
Corinth Canal

Arrive in Itea and journey inland to UNESCO World Heritage-listed Delphi, revered as the spiritual center of the ancient Greek world.

Set amid the slopes of Mount Parnassus, this sacred sanctuary was believed to be the home of the Oracle of Delphi, whose prophecies guided kings, leaders and citizens for centuries. Explore the Sanctuary of Apollo, walk along the ancient Sacred Way and see the marble Altar of the Chians, where visitors once awaited the Oracle's divine messages. Continue to the ancient stadium, where the legendary Pythian Games were held in honor of Apollo, combining athletic competition with religious celebration. After lunch

aboard, the ship navigates the narrow Corinth Canal, an impressive feat of engineering carved through the Greek mainland and offering a memorable passage between the Ionian and Aegean seas.

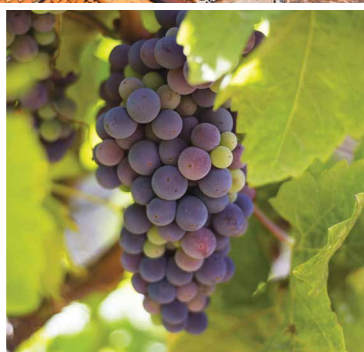
