Upon arrival, embark the deluxe *World Voyager*.

Say hello to fellow travelers over dinner aboard the ship.

Day 3 | April 26

B-L-R-D

Casablanca | Rabat

Get to know Casablanca's seamless blend of North African and French cultures during today's excursion. Begin at the impressive Hassan II Mosque, perched on a promontory by the ocean, and admire its marble flooring and Moroccan details.

Celebrated as one of Africa's largest mosques, it is one of only two open to non-Muslim visitors. Continue to Rabat, known for its relaxed, polished vibe. Dig in to a traditional Moroccan lunch.

A panoramic tour of Rabat follows. Gaze at the Royal Palace of Rabat — fronted by expansive grounds and the Parliament of Morocco — and the Chellah, a peaceful,

mysterious complex of ancient ruins, gardens and Islamic monuments. Witness the Hassan Tower, an unfinished 12th-century minaret that's one of Rabat's most iconic landmarks. Plus, step into the stately Mohammed V Mausoleum, the resting place of King Mohammed V and his sons King Hassan II and Prince Moulay Abdallah.

Tonight, gather with fellow travelers for a Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 4 | April 27

B-L-D

Tangier

Over the centuries, ancient Tangier has welcomed writers, adventurers and artists, such as Matisse and Eugène Delacroix. Embrace the

opportunity to explore the labyrinthine old medina and legendary souks. Listen to captivating stories while passing weavers and artisans with their crafts. Also, visit the vibrant Niaba Gardens, filled with bountiful floral displays, towering palm and cypress trees, fountains and sea views. After a lunch of local cuisine, take advantage of leisure time to peruse the souks and experience daily life.

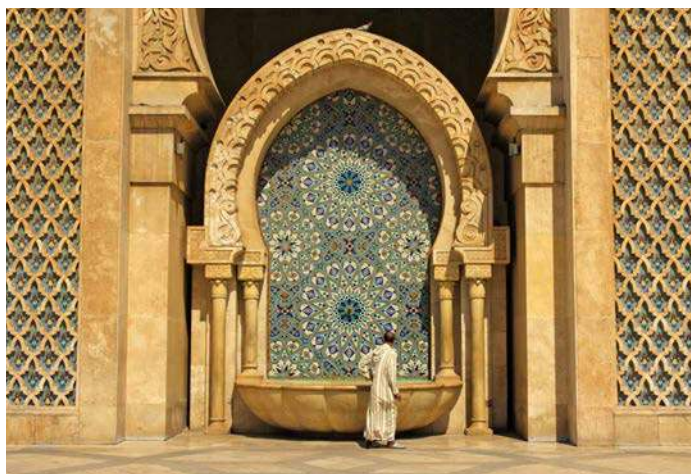
Day 5 | April 28

B-L-D

Málaga, Spain

Arrive in Málaga, located on the famous Costa del Sol, and set off to discover the city's rich history and captivating atmosphere.

Begin at the main square, the Plaza de la Constitución, followed by a visit to the Málaga Cathedral. Stroll through the charming streets toward the harbor, pausing at the Mercado de Atarazanas, a beautiful 19th-century market hall celebrated for its Moorish-inspired stained glass and striking ironwork. Next, visit the Roman Theater, nestled at the base of the beautifully preserved Moorish palace-fortress overlooking the city. Wrap up today's tour at the modern waterfront promenade, where you can experience the contemporary

art installations, palm-lined walkways, atmosphere and relaxing views. Travelers wishing for an active walk may continue up to the Alcazaba, built by Muslim rulers during the time of Al-Andalus.

Day 6 | April 29 **B-L-D**
Gibraltar, United Kingdom

Greet the morning in Gibraltar and disembark to visit The Rock of Gibraltar, considered by the ancient Greeks and Romans to be one of the two Pillars of Hercules that marked the boundary of the known world. If you wish, walk up a steep

road to stand on the "Top of the Rock" and take in views across the strait separating Europe and Africa. Continue to St. Michael's Cave, home to stunning stalagmite formations, and watch the amusing antics of Barbary macaques, Europe's only colony of wild monkeys. Explore the unique Great Siege Tunnels, excavated by British Army engineers in the late 18th century to provide defense for the colony.

Day 7 | April 30 **B-L-D**
Seville, Spain

Arrive in Seville midday and begin your discovery. Seville's streets are lined with

orange trees, alluring plazas and lively tapas bars that echo with the passionate rhythms of guitar and dance. By day, the city dazzles with historical grandeur, and by night, it comes alive with bustling cafés, music and a warm Andalusian spirit.

Day 8 | May 1 **B-L-D**

Seville

Venture out on a guided walk to see Seville's highlights, including the colorful Santa Cruz neighborhood and the magnificent UNESCO-listed Seville Cathedral. Rising on the site of a former Moorish mosque, this magnificent

Gothic cathedral began construction in 1401 and took more than a century to complete. Home to the tomb of Christopher Columbus, it features a striking blend of Moorish, Gothic, Renaissance and baroque elements that beautifully reflects the rich and diverse history of Seville.

Day 9 | May 2 **B-L-R-D**

Portimão, Portugal | Lagos

Relax while cruising this morning before arriving in Portimão to explore the historic town of Lagos. Discover the statue of Infante Dom Henrique, honoring Prince Henry the Navigator,

and visit the baroque Church of Santo António. Continue to the historic Mercado de Escravos, the site of Europe's first slave market, where the past comes vividly to life.

Join a Farewell Reception and Dinner tonight.

Day 10 | May 3 **B**

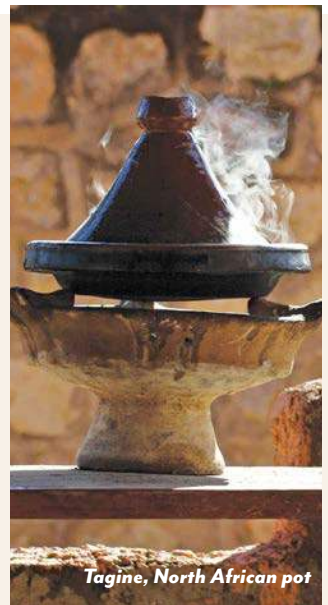
Lisbon | Disembark | Return to Home City
