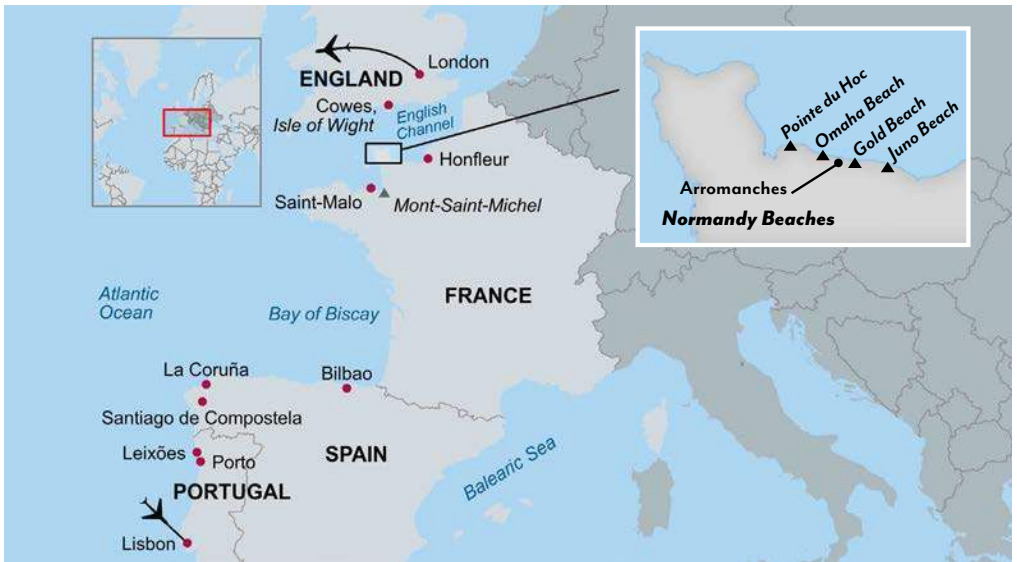

Day 1 | May 2

Depart your home city on an overnight flight to Portugal.

Day 2 | May 3

Lisbon, Portugal | Embark
Arrive in Lisbon and embark *World Voyager*.

Day 3 | May 4

B-L-R-D

Leixões | Porto

Delight in stunning views during breakfast while cruising toward Leixões for a day of discovery. Disembark for Porto, a UNESCO World Heritage Site recognized for its Romanesque monuments and medieval old town, full of beautiful, symbolic buildings. Humans have occupied Portugal's second-largest city since the 8th century B.C., when excavations show evidence of a Phoenician trading settlement.

Set off on your chosen Traveler's Choice activity. Join a distinguished local purveyor and indulge in Porto's world-renowned port wine during an immersive tasting experience. Sample a curated selection of rich vintages

thoughtfully paired with artisanal cheeses. Alternatively, you may join a walking tour of Porto's monuments, including the Palácio da Bolsa, the Stock Exchange Palace. This exquisite building has British Neoclassical and Palladian influences. Inside, gaze at elaborate paintings, décor and sculptures.

Attend tonight's Welcome Reception, followed by dinner.

Day 4 | May 5

B-L-D

La Coruña, Spain |
Santiago de Compostela
Following breakfast; disembark for an excursion to the UNESCO-inscribed Santiago de Compostela.

Located in the autonomous region of Galicia, it has been a world-renowned pilgrimage site since the 9th century, when a light was seen shining over a forgotten Roman tomb believed to be that of St. James the Great. Today, stroll along stone streets to the grand gathering square of Praza do Obradoiro, where you may admire the splendid Palacio de Rajoy. Visit the hallowed sanctuary of Spain's patron saint — a legendary cathedral that holds the remains of St. James — to marvel at the ornate blend of styles on its interior, ranging from Romanesque to baroque. This is the final destination

of the legendary Camino de Santiago (Way of St. James), and you may see pilgrims and hikers arriving.

Day 5 | May 6 **B-L-D**

Santander | Bilbao

Take in pretty countryside panoramas on a drive to Bilbao. A member of the UNESCO Creative Cities Network, ancient Bilbao has become famous for its cultural transformation and innovations in architecture, interior design and fashion.

Upon arrival in Bilbao, join your Traveler's Choice outing. Either tour a dynamic collection of modern and contemporary art at Frank Gehry's titanium-clad Guggenheim Museum or enjoy a Basque cuisine demonstration, including tastings! The Basque region is known for rich, flavorful cuisine where time-honored recipes and cutting-edge gastronomy coexist.

Day 6 | May 7 **B-L-D**

Day at Sea

Spend today gliding on the Bay of Biscay. Relax and enjoy the ship's many luxury amenities.

Day 7 | May 8 **B-L-D**

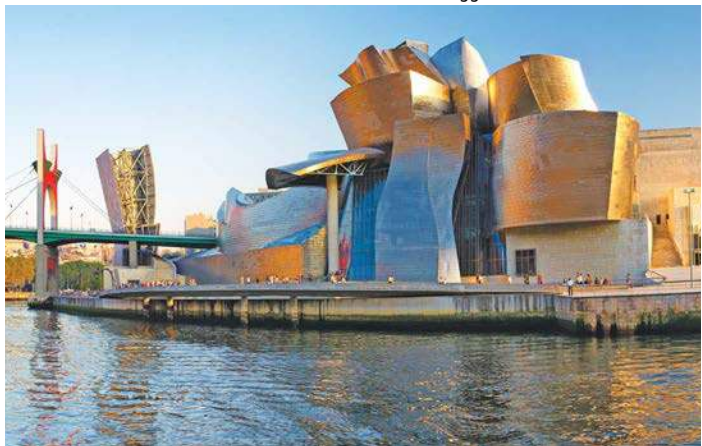
Saint-Malo, France | Mont-Saint-Michel

Disembark at Saint-Malo, the fortified French port city where maritime explorer Jacques Cartier was born in the 15th century. From here, travel to majestic Mont-Saint-Michel, a pilgrimage site for more than 1,000 years. Rising from a tidal plain that appears to be suspended above the sea, this UNESCO World Heritage Site is a vision of soaring spires isolated beyond a stretch of saltwater marsh. Cobblestone streets weave through the village, culminating at the Mont-

Saint-Michel Abbey, a three-story Gothic masterpiece. Admire the serene cloisters, barrel-roofed réfectoire and Salle des Hôtes of the 13th-century La Merveille and the magnificent Église Abbatiale. Join David Eisenhower for an engaging lecture about tomorrow's excursion.

Day 8 | May 9 **B-L-D**

Honfleur | Normandy Beaches

From Honfleur, make the solemn pilgrimage with David Eisenhower to the historic Normandy beaches, site of the largest seaborne invasion in history. Take a powerful and moving journey through history with guided visits to Pointe du Hoc and Omaha Beach, two of the most

significant sites of the D-Day landings on June 6, 1944. Following lunch, join your group for a wreath-laying ceremony at the American Military Cemetery. Then continue to Arromanches with David Eisenhower to see the remnants of the Mulberry "A" harbor, which was transported across the English Channel to support Allied landings on the Normandy beaches.

Return to the ship and share your day's experiences over dinner with friends.

Cowes, Isle of Wight

Arrive in Cowes on the Isle of Wight, a world-famous sailing destination known for its vibrant maritime

His 1986 bestseller, "Eisenhower: At War 1943–1945," was a finalist for the Pulitzer Prize in History. Eisenhower received a B.A. in history cum laude from Amherst College. Following graduation, he served in the United States Naval Reserve for three years as an officer on the USS Albany; shortly afterward, he earned his J.D. cum laude from The George Washington University Law School. Today, Eisenhower is Senior Fellow of the Foreign Policy Research Institute and a Public Policy Fellow at the Annenberg School of Communication and the School of Arts and Sciences at the University of Pennsylvania, where he teaches "Communication and the Presidency."

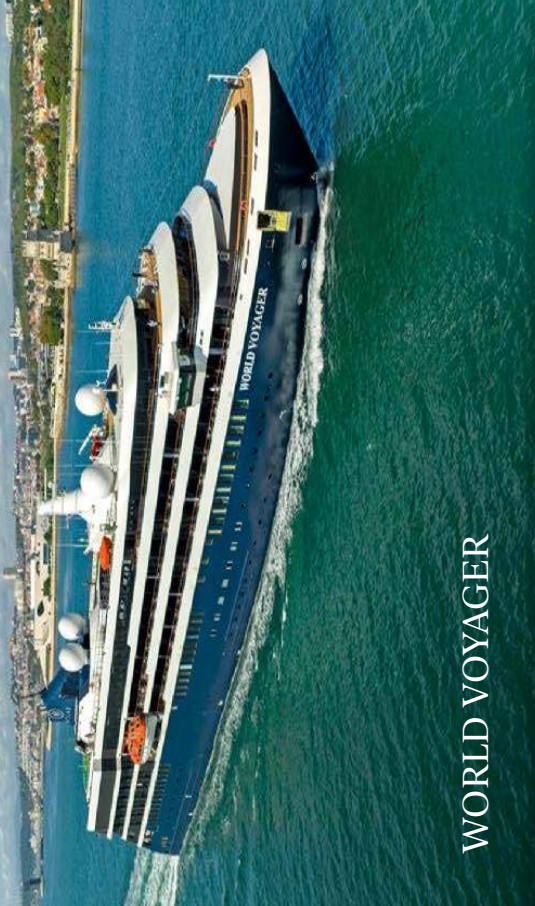
