Day 1 | June 15

Depart your home city for Geneva, Switzerland.

Day 2 | June 16 R

Geneva, Switzerland | Montreux

Take a scenic guided transfer to beautiful Montreux, where you'll check in to the first-class *Grand Hotel Suisse Majestic* hotel, with panoramic views of Lake Geneva and the Alps. This afternoon, take a guided walk of the town, known as the Jewel of the Swiss Riviera. Stroll along the lakeside promenade and through the picturesque Old Town, with its cobbled streets and multi-colored stone buildings. Join your fellow travelers for a Welcome Reception this evening.

Day 3 | June 17 B-L

Montreux | Lake Geneva

Visit the 13th-century Chateau de Chillon, an imposing medieval castle situated at the lake's edge. Then board a Belle Époque paddle-wheel steamboat for a cruise along the shores of Lake Geneva. This scenic body of water

— the largest lake in central Europe — was a requisite stop on the Grand Tour of Europe during the 19th century, and its beautiful vistas inspired many artists and writers. Savor a delicious lunch in the ship's elegant dining room as forested hillsides and lovely villages glide by.

Day 4 | June 18 B-L

Gruyères | Broc

By train, travel along the Golden Pass route — gazing out at breathtaking Alpine scenery — from Montreux to Montbovon. From there, a short countryside drive takes you to the charming medieval

town of Gruyères. At a local cheese factory, discover the secrets of the town's world-famous cheese, watch its production and try some samples. After lunch in one of the charming restaurants lining the cobblestoned main street, continue to the small village of Broc. Tour a chocolate factory to learn the secrets of chocolate-making and taste the delicious final product.

Day 5 | June 19 B-L-D

Basel | Breisach, Germany | Embark

Marvel at the beautiful vistas on a drive to Basel. Ancient Basilia was a Roman settlement

established in 44 B.C. — nowadays it's a vibrant, art-filled city. Enjoy a guided tour and lunch at a local restaurant. Transfer to Breisach, Germany and embark *Amadeus Queen*, then settle in to your cabin.

Day 6 | June 20 B-L-R-D

Strasbourg, France

Discover the grandeur of Grand-Île, the historic center of Strasbourg and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, during a walking tour. See the bridges and watchtowers of the 13th-century Ponts Couverts, and meander past the half-timbered houses in the canal-lined Petite France

district, where tanners, millers and fishermen lived during the Middle Ages. Visit Notre-Dame Cathedral, an exquisitely ornamented Gothic beauty. Join the Welcome Reception and Dinner tonight.

Day 7 | June 21 B-L-D

Mannheim, Germany for Heidelberg

Journey to romantic Heidelberg to visit the ruins of its grand castle, built in the 13th century, overlooking the picturesque Neckar Valley. Take a walking tour in the lively Altstadt (Old Town), filled with Renaissance and Baroque gems such as the old bridge, Alte Brücke.

Day 8 | June 22 B-L-D

Rüdesheim | Rhine Gorge

Arrive in the heart of Riesling wine country today.

Aboard the Winzerexpress, a mini train, tour the vineyards and take in a stunning view of Rüdesheim and the Rhine. Wrap up with a wine tasting in the picturesque Old Town.

Return to the riverboat to cruise the enchanting Upper Middle Rhine Valley, also known as the Rhine Gorge. This UNESCO World Heritage Site is dotted with some 40 hilltop castles, palaces and fortresses. Marvel at the breathtaking vistas, complete with vineyard terraces along the steep valley walls. Admire the striking outcrop called Lorelei Rock — a symbol of Rhine Romanticism that inspired myriad poems and songs.

Day 9 | June 23 B-L-D

Cochem

Sail through a splendid, narrow section of the Moselle

River, lined with colorful towns and green hillsides, then dock in charming Cochem. On a walking tour, stroll the cobbled streets and admire the squares and half-timbered houses. Visit Reichsburg Castle, perched atop a cliff of tiered vineyards, with spectacular views of the river, valley and town.

Day 10 | June 24 **B-L-D**
Cologne

One of the largest European cities in medieval and Renaissance times, Cologne is known for its lively spirit. On a walking tour in the historic

Old Town, appreciate the colorful buildings, stately squares and riverfront views. Cologne may be most famous for its magnificent Gothic cathedral, Kölner Dom, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This location has been occupied by Christian churches since the fourth century, and the current cathedral was built over a period of more than 630 years, completed in 1880.

Day 11 | June 25 **B-L-R-D**
Cruising | Amsterdam, Netherlands

As we sail to the Netherlands, enjoy time this morning on the riverboat. Exercise in the

fitness center, indulge in a sauna in the wellness area, or simply relax on deck with a book. After a delicious lunch, disembark in Amsterdam. Set off on a private cruise of the world-famous UNESCO-inscribed canals, which have been connecting the city since the early 17th century. Glide under iconic bridges and past brightly colored houses and stately stone buildings. This evening, bid adieu to newfound friends at the Farewell Reception and Dinner.

Day 12 | June 26 **B**
Amsterdam | Disembark | Return to Home City

After breakfast, disembark and transfer to the airport for your return flight home.
