Day 1 | May 24

Depart your home city for a flight to Rome, Italy.

Day 2 | May 25

Rome, Italy | Embark

Arrive in Rome. Transfer and embark *Wind Spirit*. Enjoy dinner on board this evening.

Day 3 | May 26

B-L-R-D

Bonifacio, Corsica, France

Bonifacio, on the French island of Corsica, has a truly dramatic natural setting, perched on high cliffs. Begin with a tram ride from the harbor to Haute Ville (upper town) with its panoramic vistas. A walking tour will take you to the Citadel and old town to see St. Dominique church, Place Bir Hakeim, St. Jean Baptiste church and Le Grain de Sable — a limestone rock formation. Explore the Jardin des Vestiges and see where Napoleon stayed.

Gather for a Welcome Reception tonight.

Day 4 | May 27

B-L-D

Day at Sea

Spend a relaxing day cruising. Enjoy some of the ship's many

luxury amenities — exercise in the fitness center, indulge in a spa treatment or simply relax on deck with a book.

Day 5 | May 28

B-L-D

Porto Venere, Italy | Cinque Terre

Depart Porto Venere by private boat for an excursion to Cinque Terre (Five Lands), a collection of five picturesque villages clinging to the cliffs over the Mediterranean Sea and connected by small footpaths. Visit the villages of Vernazza, Monterosso and Porto Venere, and enjoy leisure time visiting the small shops tucked along the winding, narrow streets.

Day 6 | May 29

Genoa

Choose an included excursion today in Genoa. During a walking tour through the old town, immerse yourself in the city's medieval core with its range of architectural styles, shops, restaurants and cafes. Marvel at the incredible Palazzi dei Rolli. Or enjoy a scenic drive to see the historic buildings. Both excursions wrap up with food demonstrations and tastings.

Day 7 | May 30

Nice, France | Monaco

Venture out to experience Nice in a private, electric mini train.

Bonifacio

See some of the city's iconic highlights, including the Palais de la Préfecture and beautiful Baroque churches. Climb Castle Hill for a panoramic view overlooking the city and the beautiful blue water that the Côte d'Azur is named for.

This afternoon, choose between two excursions in Monaco. Opt to join an expert local guide to stroll through the old town, admiring the historic buildings and beautiful

architecture. Visit the Cathedral of Our Lady Immaculate, where many of the Grimaldis are buried, including Grace Kelly and Rainier III. On one option, follow up with a tour of the Prince's Palace, built as an Italian fortress in A.D. 1191. Marvel at the lavish décor in the State Apartments, home to Monaco's royals. On another option, tour Monaco and spend time exploring the Oceanographic Museum, which combines art, architecture and science

and houses a spectacular multi-level aquarium.

Day 8 | May 31 **B-L-D**
Marseille

After lunch on board, choose one of two possible excursions today. Spend a leisurely day in the "City of a Thousand Fountains," Aix-en-Provence, birthplace of Paul Cezanne. Stroll the elegant Cours Mirabeau Avenue, lined with trees and 17th- and 18th-century mansions. Meander along winding alleys in the historic town center. Soak up lovely architecture, parks, gardens — and of course,

fountains — in this delightful city. Or choose to stay in Marseille. On a guided tour, see the Old Port with its picturesque marina, guarded by two historic forts. Visit the hilltop Notre-Dame de Garde and admire panoramic views of the city. Drive along the famous Corniche Kennedy, skirting the Mediterranean, past the Prado Beach and the Longchamp Palace. Wrap up at Le Panier, the historic hillside neighborhood.

Day 9 | June 1

B-L-R-D

Port Vendres

Choose one of two possible excursions today. Drive to Carcassonne, one of the best-preserved medieval cities in Europe. Visit La Porte

Narbonnaise, the Castle of the Counts and the Basilica St. Nazaire. Climb the ramparts and spy the watchtowers (the fortress has 52!). There's even a moat, nowadays filled with a lovely garden. Enjoy lunch on your own at a charming cafe, and browse the galleries and shops. Alternatively, journey to the town of Collioure, the "Jewel of the Vermeille Coast," where many great painters found their inspiration. Trace the origins of the vibrant Fauvism movement with a guided walking tour through the old town

and along the picturesque, palm-lined harbor. Cap off your visit with a tasting at a traditional anchovy workshop.

Tonight, bid adieu to your fellow passengers at a Farewell Reception and Dinner.

Legends of La Côte d'Azur

In 1887, French writer Stephen Liégeard attempted to define the allure of a strip of Mediterranean coast between Marseille and Italy — an emerging winter destination for Europe's wealthy and elite. His book was titled "La Côte d'Azur" and from that time forward, this "short but delicious" route along the Riviera coast of France and Italy would become known as such. English aristocracy began flocking to the area as early as the 18th century for luxurious holidays. The addition of a railway line in the mid- to late-19th century ensured access to a dazzling enclave of grand hotels and casinos that are

now known collectively as the Riviéras. Today, these sparkling coastlines famously epitomize a glamorous age that captured the popular imagination in everything from F. Scott Fitzgerald's novel "Tender is the Night" to the 1955 film set in Monaco, "To Catch a Thief" (starring American actress Grace Kelly, who became princess of Monaco!).
