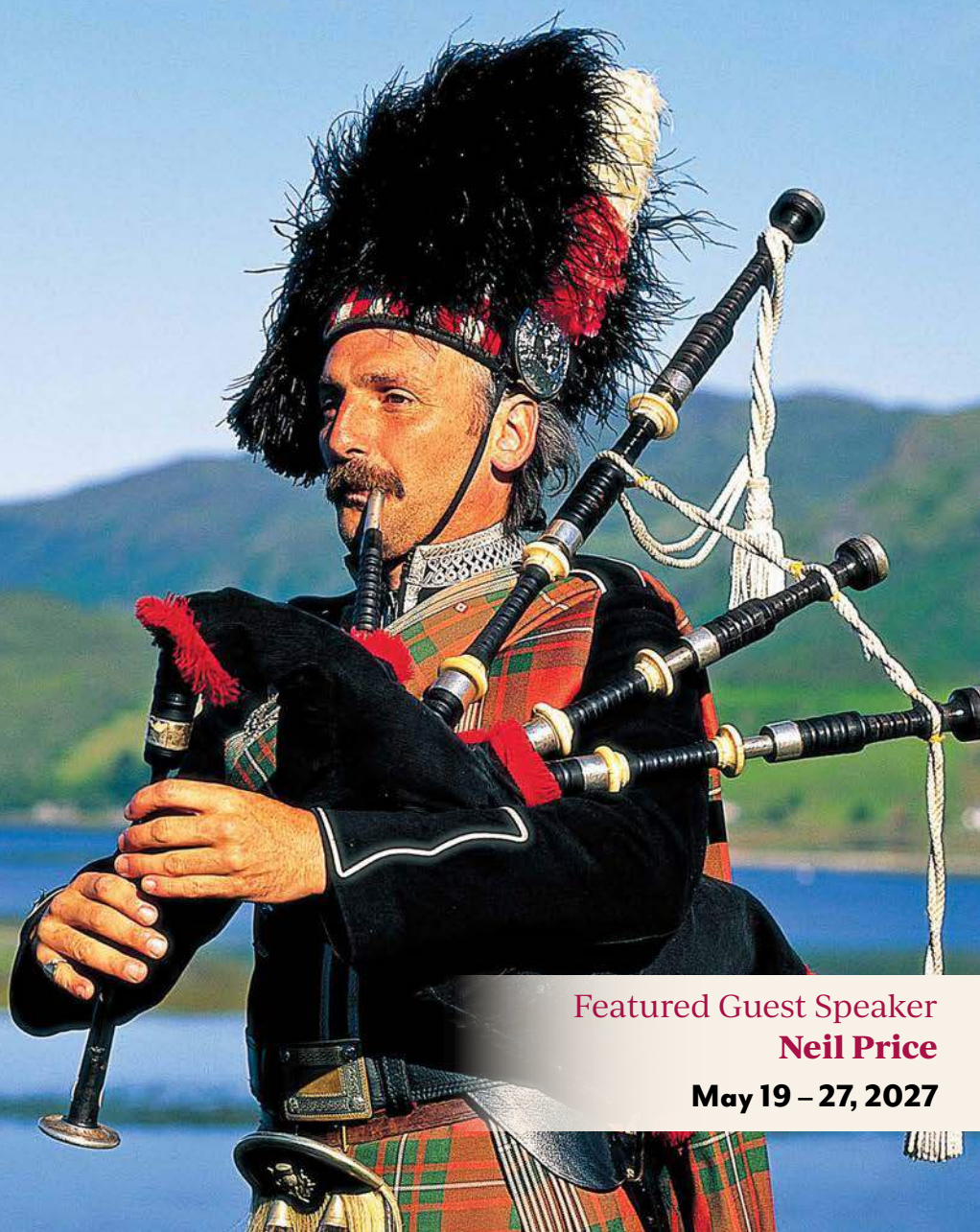

**Day 1 | May 19**

Depart your home city for Glasgow, Scotland.

**Day 2 | May 20****D**

Glasgow, Scotland | Embark Ship

Arrive in Glasgow and transfer to embark *World Voyager*. Unpack and settle in.

**Day 3 | May 21****B-L-R-D**

Isle of Iona

Visit the Inner Hebridean Isle of Iona, the birthplace of Christianity in Scotland. Enjoy a guided tour of Iona Abbey and see the burial site of numerous Scottish clan chiefs and kings (including Macbeth, buried here in 1057!). Take in the impressive collection of over 180 medieval carved stones and crosses. Enjoy free time to explore the lovely little shops and cafes of the village. Return to the ship for lunch and a relaxing afternoon on board. Get to know your fellow travelers at a Welcome Reception and Dinner this evening.

**Day 4 | May 22****B-L-D**

Stornoway, Isle of Lewis

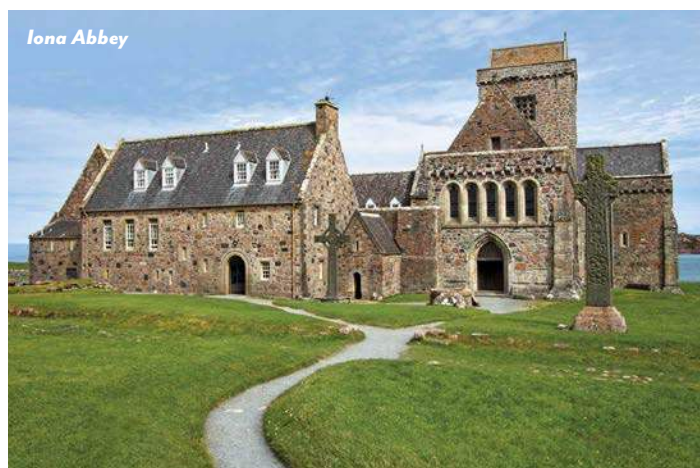
On the Isle of Lewis, embark on one of two exciting excursion options. Visit Scotland's Stonehenge, the Callanish Standing Stones, which date from around 3,000 B.C. Then travel to Gearranan Blackhouse Village, a traditional crofter's village of thatched-roof stone houses made entirely from local materials. Or, enjoy an exclusive tour of the impressive Lews Castle, a Gothic Revival-style home built in the mid-1800s by the island's one-time owner. Then visit Museum Nan Eilean, which focuses on life

in the Outer Hebrides from prehistory to the present day, with exhibits including significant archaeological finds. Return to the ship for lunch, or stay in town and enjoy a meal in one of the local restaurants or cafes. Spend the afternoon at leisure, exploring Stornoway on your own. You can shop for authentic Harris Tweed, stroll the walking trails on the Lews Castle grounds and sample local food — Stornoway is famous for its Black Pudding!

**Day 5 | May 23****B-L-D**

Kirkwall, Orkney Islands

Head into the west of Mainland, Orkney's largest island, to visit





the Neolithic Heartland of Orkney, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. View the sacred Standing Stones of Stenness and visit the early Orcadian settlement of Skara Brae to see the dwellings revealed from beneath the sand dunes. Then, follow the coastline of Scapa Flow, made famous for its role in both World Wars, before visiting St. Magnus Cathedral. Also known as the “Light of the North,” the cathedral was built by Vikings during their 500-year reign over the islands.

**Day 6 | May 24** **B-L-D**  
**Lerwick, Shetland Islands**

Disembark in Lerwick and travel to the island’s southernmost point, passing Mousa Broch, the tallest and best-preserved broch in the world. Visit the incredible archaeological site of Jarlshof. See the remains of more than 4,000 years of human history, including an Iron Age broch and wheelhouse, late-Neolithic stone houses, a Bronze Age village, Norse longhouses and a 16th-century

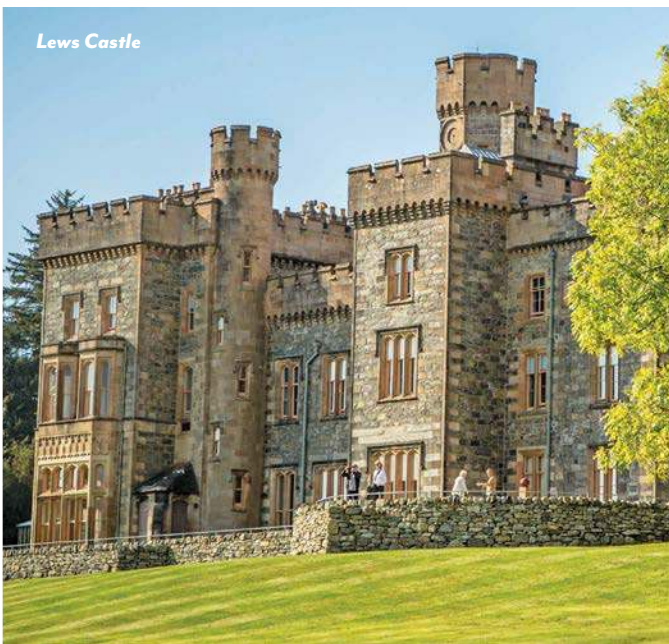
laird’s house. Look for sightings of Shetland’s famous ponies on the way back to the ship.

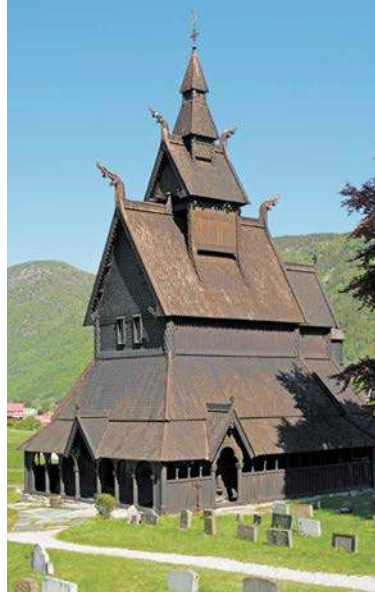
**Day 7 | May 25** **B-L-D**  
**Sognefjord, Norway/  
Vik-i-Sogn**

This morning, cruise the mighty Sognefjord, passing traditional farmsteads and villages flanked by majestic mountains and waterfalls. Enjoy a delicious lunch as the ship sails to Vik-i-Sogn, a picturesque village nestled within the awe-inspiring landscapes of Norway’s fjords. Here, set off on one of two afternoon options. Take a captivating walking tour, passing three unique

churches, each representing a distinct historical era. Wrap up with a delightful visit to the Ostebaren (cheese bar), where you can savor a local delicacy: Gamalosten, a Viking-era cheese served alongside freshly made raspberry juice. On another option, take a scenic ferry ride across the fjord to Balestrand, home of the family-run Balestrand Cider House. Tour the organic orchard, which boasts over 100 varieties of fruit, and sample the juice and cider produced here. Finish with a tour of the village.

### Day 8 | May 26 **B-L-R-D** Bergen

Take a walking tour of the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Bryggen, Bergen's historic waterfront. The old wharf is a reminder of the town's importance as part of the Hanseatic League's trading empire from the 14th to the mid-16th century. Pass through the bustling fish market, and take the funicular up Mount Fløyen for stunning 360-degree views of the city, the harbor and the surrounding mountains and islands. Spend the rest of the day exploring Bergen on your own. You might choose to

walk one of the beautiful nearby nature trails or stop in shops and galleries in the downtown area. Return to the ship for lunch or opt to stay in town and eat at one of the many cafes and restaurants. Bid adieu to your fellow travelers at this evening's Farewell Reception and Dinner.

### Day 9 | May 27 **B**

#### Bergen/Disembark/ Return to Home City

Following breakfast, disembark the ship and transfer to the Bergen Airport for your return flight home.

Neil Price is Distinguished Professor of Archaeology at the University of Uppsala in Sweden, where he also leads the Centre for the World in the Viking Age. A leading specialist in Norse history and traditional religions, his many publications include "The Viking Way," "The Vikings" and "The Children of Ash and Elm: A History of the Vikings," which was named a Times (UK) and Sunday Times Best History Book of the Year. Neil frequently consults on TV

and film projects, including documentaries for the History Channel and "The Northman" movie. He currently directs one of Scandinavia's largest archaeological research projects, "The Viking Phenomenon."
