

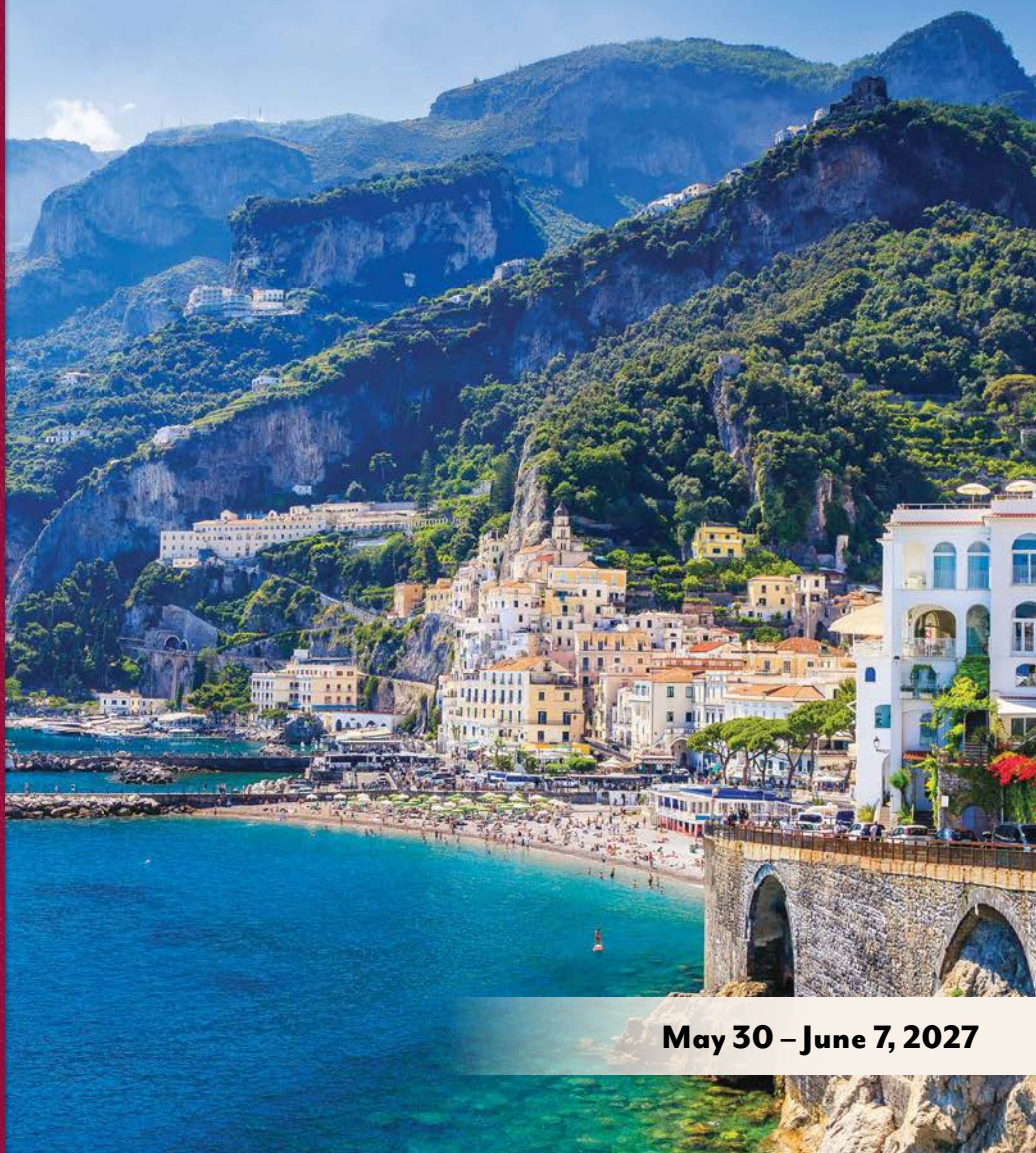

Day 1 | May 30

Depart your home city for Rome, Italy.

Day 2 | May 31 **R-D**

Rome, Italy | Embark

Touch down in Rome; then transfer and embark the deluxe *World Traveller*.

Say hello to fellow travelers over a Welcome Reception and Dinner aboard the ship.

Day 3 | June 1 **B-L-D**

Livorno

Your adventure begins! Disembark the ship in Livorno and set off on your chosen Traveler’s Choice excursion. Your options include traveling to Florence for a walking tour and to visit to the Galleria dell’Accademia di Firenze and see Michelangelo’s legendary David; journeying to the 16th-century walled city of Lucca to visit the Puccini Museum and the Villa Reale di Marlia; or joining an afternoon excursion to Pisa to discover the magnificent Piazza dei Miracoli, or Square of Miracles — a UNESCO World Heritage Site celebrated for its beauty and rich history.

Day 4 | June 2 **B-L-D**

Porto Venere | Cinque Terre

Enjoy extraordinary views as the ship arrives in the medieval Porto Venere. Disembark after breakfast for a private boat cruise to the astounding Cinque Terre, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Visit two of its iconic cliffside villages, Vernazza and Monterosso, with time at leisure to explore at your own pace. You have the option to return to the ship for lunch or remain in Porto Venere for lunch on your own with extra time to enjoy the coastal scenery.

Day 5 | June 3 **B-L-D**

Bonifacio, Corsica, France

The French island town of Bonifacio welcomes you this morning. Your exploration of this dramatically perched medieval gem begins with a tram ride from the harbor up to the Haute Ville, or upper town. Wander through Bonifacio’s ninth-century citadel, where highlights include Place Bir Hakeim, the Church of St. Jean Baptiste, and Le Grain de Sable — a striking rock formation that appears to teeter into the sea. Take time to enjoy the tranquil Jardin des Vestiges and visit

the house where Napoleon Bonaparte once stayed.

Day 6 | June 4 **B-L-D**

Porto Cervo, Sardinia, Italy

After breakfast, choose from three enriching excursions tailored to your interests. You may set out on a scenic journey along the dazzling Costa Smeralda, where charming villages, dramatic coastal landscapes and hidden historical treasures unfold at every turn. Pause at the Belvedere, a celebrated view point offering sweeping panoramas of Sardinia's turquoise shoreline — an ideal moment to capture the region's natural beauty. Alternatively,

enjoy a picturesque drive from Porto Cervo to a welcoming winery in the heart of the Gallura region. Here, a guided visit introduces you to the island's rich wine-making heritage, complemented by insights into local traditions and flavors. For a more leisurely experience, head to a nearby beach to relax on soft sands, take a refreshing swim in crystal-clear waters, or explore beneath the surface if you wish to snorkel.

Day 7 | June 5 **B-L-D**

Sorrento | Pompeii

Arrive in Sorrento, an outpost of the ancient Roman Republic and the scenic gateway to Mount Vesuvius and Pompeii.

This seaside town of rose-flushed buildings was built into picturesque cliffs high above the Tyrrhenian Sea and is abundant with fragrant lemon and orange groves.

Depart for your excursion to the ancient city of Pompeii. Engulfed by the tephra of Mount Vesuvius in 79 A.D., Pompeii was frozen in time for centuries. Excavated 17 centuries after petrification, the UNESCO-designated ruins reveal in intimate detail Roman daily rituals during Emperor Titus' reign. Explore the ruins on foot to see the wealthy Vetti family estate, the extraordinary and earliest surviving stone amphitheater

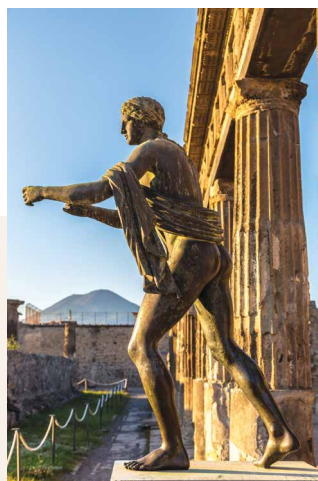

of the Roman world and the Temple of Jupiter. Choose to return to the ship for lunch or stay in Sorrento and find a local café for lunch on your own. Shuttle buses will provide transportation from the port to the city center.

Back on board, enjoy dinner and a traditional tarantella performance with Neapolitan songs and dance.



offering a rare snapshot of Roman life frozen in time. Visitors can walk through remarkably intact streets, explore villas with vivid frescoes, and see public spaces such as the forum and amphitheater. The city is spectacular to visit because it allows you to step directly into history, witnessing how people lived nearly 2,000 years ago. The haunting preservation and scale of the site create an unforgettable experience that blends tragedy, beauty and discovery in a single place that continues to inspire archaeological study worldwide.

Day 8 | June 6 B-L-R-D

Sorrento | Amalfi

Admire the natural splendor of the UNESCO World Heritage-designated Amalfi Coast on a panoramic drive passing sun-drenched beaches to the village of Amalfi. At its heart, Amalfi enchants visitors with its lively piazzas, narrow winding lanes and the striking Duomo di Amalfi, whose grand staircase and intricate façade dominate the skyline. Once a powerful maritime republic, Amalfi today offers a perfect blend of history and coastal beauty. After an

orientation tour, spend time on your own to explore the charming local boutiques and cafés. Purchase some traditional hand-painted ceramics or savor a gelato at the waterfront.

Join your fellow travelers for a Farewell Reception on board the ship this evening.

Day 9 | June 7 B

Naples | Disembark | Return to Home City

After breakfast, bid farewell to Naples, disembark the ship and transfer to the airport for your flight home.

Pompeii ~ Frozen in Time

Pompeii is an ancient Roman city near Naples, Italy, destroyed in 79 A.D. when Mount Vesuvius erupted, burying it under ash and pumice. This catastrophic event preserved buildings, streets, mosaics, and even everyday objects in extraordinary detail. Rediscovered in the 18th century, Pompeii became one of the most important archaeological sites in the world,
