SHORE EXCURSIONS

In the mornings and afternoons, passengers may be departing to or returning from shore excursions. If you intend to participate in shore excursions during your cruise, please wear clothing you suitable for walking a minimum of a mile in, often on uneven surfaces and in varying temperatures.

LIFE ON BOARD

The atmosphere on board the ship is relaxed luxury, or smart casual. This attire combines elegance with comfort, embodying a sophisticated yet laid-back style. For dinners in the formal dining area, we ask guests to refrain from wearing shorts or t-shirts.

Indoor areas of the ship are air conditioned. We recommend lightweight, comfortable clothing that can be layered for moving between the outdoor decks and indoor spaces. A Sweater, light jacket, or shawl is recommended for your comfort as well as during various shore excursions.

SMART CASUAL

For ladies:

GALA EVENING

There will be two gala evenings on board each cruise, known as the Captain's Welcome and the Captain's Farewell. We invite you to bring one or two more formal outfits for these evenings.

- Dress shirt
- Tie (not mandatory)

- Activewear and sneakers




ITEMS AND EQUIPMENT

- Camera with extra film/SD cards, batteries, and charger
- Collapsible walking poles
- Binoculars
- RFID locking lined wallet, travel pouch, and passport holder
- Travel notebook and pen
- Universal power adapter and charging cords
- Quick dry travel towel
- Plastic bags of varying sizes, including zip-lock types
- Laundry bag

TOILETRIES

- Standard toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, makeup, etc.)
- Moisturizer
- Chapstick or lip balm
- Sunscreen and after sun products
- Insect repellent and after-bite products
- Small first aid kit (band aids, Neosporin, etc.)
- Motion sickness preventatives
- Personal medications and prescriptions
- Eye mask and ear plugs
- Hand sanitizer
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) such as a face mask

Depending on the itinerary and the program of your cruise, an Officers' evening on the theme "White Party" may be organized. Therefore, we encourage you to bring a smart casual or elegant white (or white and black) outfit.


OTHER CONSIDERATIONS



Your stateroom will be equipped with both 110-volt AC outlets (North American standard), as well as 200-volt AC outlets (European standard).



Laundry and pressing services are available on board for an additional fee. We are unable to offer dry cleaning services. For safety reasons, your stateroom is not equipped with an iron.



Each stateroom is equipped with a safe. We recommend that you do not go ashore with valuable jewelry.



Our onboard boutique offers a selection of apparel, jewelry, and accessories.



We recommend that you bring no more than one checked bag, one carry-on bag, and one personal item for your cruise. Additional luggage may be subject to airline fees and may necessitate transfers with additional storage capacity. Please refer to your air service provider for information on luggage size and weight restrictions.

Out of an abundance of caution and in case delivery of your luggage is delayed by the airline, we suggest keeping medication, toiletries, and a change of clothes in your carry-on or hand luggage. We strongly recommend keeping important travel documents and passport copies on your person as well.
