Lazy Bear Lodge

This remarkable, handcrafted log lodge is a welcoming, rugged retreat that offers a deep connection to the pristine surroundings.

Built with care from locally and sustainably sourced materials, the two-story lodge blends rustic authenticity with modern comfort. Its Douglas fir floors—reclaimed from a Canadian National Railway warehouse built in the early 1920s—and windows once part of a 19th-century Hudson Bay Trading Post lend each space a tangible link to northern heritage.

Between adventures, unwind by the crackling fire in the inviting lounge and savor hearty northern cuisine at the Lazy Bear Café.

With its distinctive character, friendly staff and inspiring surroundings, the lodge provides a memorable haven in the heart of the wild.

Lodge rooms are cozy and warm. Each room has two double beds, one luggage rack, one small clothes rack, a small desk, one small nightstand and a small bathroom shelf large enough to hold a few small items.

Room Amenities: Two double beds, cable television with movie channels, complimentary Wi-Fi, coffee maker, and en suite bathroom with shower, sundries and hair dryer.
