INDONESIA **Bali, Borneo and Beyond** **Aboard the 140-passenger *Heritage Adventurer***

September 25–October 8, 2027
(14 days)

We are delighted to return to Indonesia, this time with a nine-night private charter of the *Heritage Adventurer*. This program celebrates the mosaic of vibrant cultural traditions and the stunning natural beauty found in the Indonesian archipelago. Participants will be treated to a rich blend of traditional demonstrations and performances alongside wildlife walks and snorkeling the warm, crystalline waters. The end of September and early October are ideal times to visit, offering sunny weather, warm temperatures, and fewer crowds than the peak summer months. *Heritage Adventurer* offers snorkeling equipment, a full fleet of 14 Zodiacs and an outstanding expedition team of 10 naturalists, which allows the group to enjoy snorkeling encounters and remote island exploration. Another important advantage of the *Heritage Adventurer* is the ability to offer cabins for singles with a significantly lower single supplement.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Enjoy two nights of 5-star beachfront accommodation in Bali and nine nights aboard the deluxe, spacious *Heritage Adventurer*
- Visit three UNESCO World Heritage sites: **Tanjung Puting National Park**, Borneo; the Buddhist **Borobudur Temple** Compound, Java; and **Komodo National Park**, Komodo Island
- Witness **orangutans** interacting in their natural habitat at Camp Leakey, a world-famous rehabilitation and release site located in Tanjung Puting National Park; stroll the scenic beaches and trails of Komodo National Park to look for water buffalo, Timor deer, birds and the park's namesake, the **Komodo dragon**.
- Engage with community members through **specially arranged experiences**, including a cooking demonstration, gamelan orchestra performance, a weaving demonstration, and overview of the traditional *subak* water management of a terraced rice field
- Enjoy multiple opportunities to **swim** and **snorkel** amidst vibrant sea life in turquoise waters, including reef fish, sharks, sea turtles, manta rays, and dolphins.
- Journey by jeep across the "Sea of Sand" to the base of **Mount Bromo** volcano, where you can opt to **ascend to the rim** for views of the smoking crater.

SHIP INFORMATION



Originally built as the MS *Hanseatic*—one of the most acclaimed expedition ships of its era—the *Heritage Adventurer* now welcomes just 140 guests, ensuring uncommon space, comfort, and advantages such as faster disembarkations and reduced single supplements. Owned and operated by Heritage Expeditions, a Kiwi-owned pioneer in remote travel since 1985, the *Heritage Adventurer* boasts a fleet of 14 Zodiacs maximizes time ashore or on the water.



The ship's 90 well-appointed cabins offer separate living and sleeping areas, king or twin beds, ample storage, a writing desk, and modern ensuite bathrooms. Public spaces include two panoramic lounges, a 360-degree Observation Deck, and both a gourmet restaurant and indoor/outdoor bistro. Amenities span a heated saltwater pool, glass-enclosed hot tub, sauna, steam room, gym, and spa.

Sat-Sun Sep 25-26	Depart U.S.		Overnight flight to Bali, crossing the International Date Line.
Mon Sep 27	Bali	Merusaka Nusa Dua or equiv.	Arrive Densapar Airport (DPS); group transfer to beachfront resort. Welcome orientation & reception. R
Tue Sep 28	Bali	Merusaka Nusa Dua or equiv.	Lecture #1 ; visit the emerald Jatiluwh Rice Terraces in Bali's central highlands; delicious barbecue dinner this evening. BD
Wed Sep 29	Bali	<i>Heritage Adventurer</i>	Visit Bali Museum to view paintings, crafts, tools, costumes and masks; private Gamelan orchestra demonstration; embark this afternoon. BLD
Thu Sep 30	Probolinggo, East Java	<i>Heritage Adventurer</i>	Full day of exploration to view stunning Mt. Bromo which consists of 5 overlapping stratovolcanoes. Lecture #2 ; Captain's welcome reception and dinner. BLRD
Fri Oct 1	Semarang, Java	<i>Heritage Adventurer</i>	Full day visit to view the stunning 8 th century Buddhist Borobudur temples near Yogyakarta. BLD
Sat Oct 2	At Sea	<i>Heritage Adventurer</i>	Enjoy a leisurely day on board with a full complement of 3-4 lectures as the ship sails south towards Lombok. BLD
Sun Oct 3	Camp Leakey, Tanjung Puting National Park, Borneo	<i>Heritage Adventurer</i>	Full day exploration by river (via traditional wooden "klotok" boats) to visit Camp Leakey , a world-renowned orangutan rehabilitation and release site. Observe the animals alongside researchers and park rangers. BLD
Mon Oct 4	At Sea	<i>Heritage Adventurer</i>	Enjoy a leisurely day on board; the lecture program continues. BLD
Tue Oct 5	Sumbawa Besar & Satonda Island	<i>Heritage Adventurer</i>	Lecture #9 ; morning visit to Pamulung Village to observe rice harvesting and pounding and a weaving demonstration ; afternoon snorkeling in a secluded crater formed by an ancient volcano. BLD
Wed Oct 6	Komodo National Park	<i>Heritage Adventurer</i>	Full day visit to Komodo National Park , a UNESCO World Heritage site. Guided walks to look for the famous Komodo dragon in the wild, along with deer, wild boar, water buffalo, macaque and many

			birds; snorkel amidst the colorful marine life or walk the beach. Lecture #10 before dinner. BLD
Thu Oct 7	Lombok	<i>Heritage Adventurer</i>	Final lecture followed by full day of exploration at Lombok. Options include private weaving demonstration at traditional Sasak village ; looking for sea turtles while snorkeling; explore the 18 th century Pura Lingsar temple complex. Captain's Farewell Reception and Dinner on board this evening. BLRD
Fri Oct 8	Return to U.S.		Disembark in Benoa, Bali. Transfer to airport for return flights to the U.S B
