Join us aboard the *Greg Mortimer* for an immersive journey through the Inside Passage and the wild reaches beyond. Designed for exploration, this modern expedition ship allows us to navigate remote bays and narrow channels inaccessible to many larger ships, bringing us closer to the landscapes and wildlife that define this extraordinary corner of North America.

Throughout the voyage, a veteran expedition team of naturalists, cultural specialists and two certified photo instructors will help bring the region vividly to life. Their expertise enriches every experience, whether observing wildlife, exploring the temperate rainforest or learning about the ecology and history of this remarkable region.

The *Greg Mortimer* is particularly well suited for Southeast Alaska, where each day balances active exploration with time spent enjoying the journey itself. Four dedicated Zodiac platforms maximize time ashore, while spacious observation areas, outdoor hot tubs and a panoramic sauna provide inviting spaces to take in the passing scenery.

Set out on a journey into the wild beauty of Southeast Alaska, navigating secluded coves, mist-filled fjords and the lush reaches of the largest temperate rainforest on Earth. Explore by Zodiac, kayak and on foot as you watch for whales breaching in quiet bays, brown bears foraging along salmon streams and bald eagles calling from towering spruce and hemlock. The voyage culminates at the mighty Hubbard Glacier, where a wall of luminous blue ice showcases Alaska's awe-inspiring glacial power, offering a dramatic finale to this remarkable expedition.

EXPEDITION HIGHLIGHTS

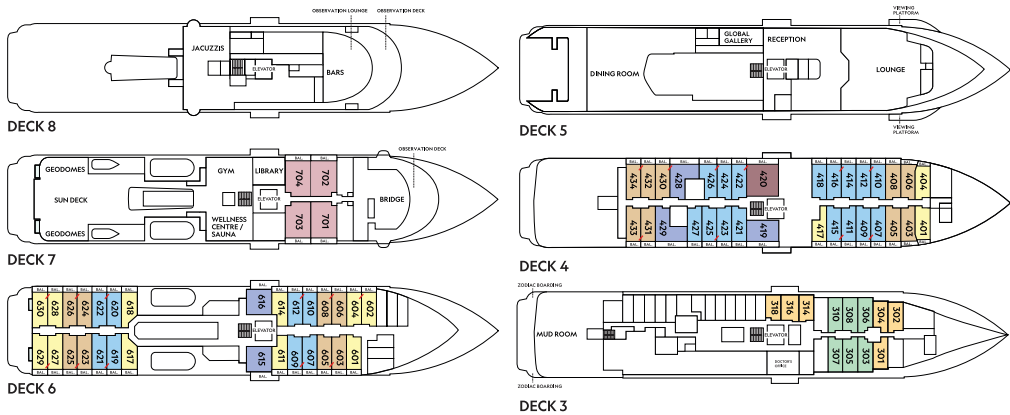
- Discover little-known coves and inlets of the Inside Passage by kayak, and seek out a host of wildlife, from brown bears and moose to several species of whale.
- Navigate spectacular icebergs—and watch for new ones calving—as you explore the face of the six-mile-wide Hubbard Glacier by Zodiac (conditions permitting).
- Kayak along sheer cliffs and forested backwaters in Misty Fjords National Monument.
- Explore the wild and remote areas of Southeast Alaska by special use permit with the Tongass National Forest.
- Soak in the midnight sun from the *Greg Mortimer's* top-deck hot tubs—perched at the ship's highest point, with 360-degree views of Alaska's dramatic wilderness unfolding around you.



Greg Mortimer

Designed for exploration and comfort in equal measure, the *Greg Mortimer* is a modern expedition vessel ideally suited to Alaska's remote waterways. Carrying just 154 guests, she offers exceptional access to secluded bays and narrow channels, while spacious observation areas, inviting public spaces and thoughtful amenities create a comfortable home base between adventures.
