**A World of Discovery**

**AHI Connects | Bahia Cuisine.** Roll up your sleeves and join a chef to learn how to make moqueca, a delicious seafood stew.

**Urca Hill & Sugarloaf Mountain.** Drive through Rio's leafy Urca neighborhood and board a cable car bound for the top of Urca Hill, which overlooks Guanabara Bay. Continue to the top of iconic Sugarloaf Mountain for a dazzling 360-degree view.

**Little Africa.** Explore Rio's African heritage in Pequena África, or Little Africa. Visit Valongo Wharf, where a quarter of all enslaved Africans brought to the Americas landed. See the Pedra do Sal, the Salt Stone, the birthplace of samba, and visit the Museum of Afro Brazilian History and Culture.

**The Magic of Carnaval.** Learn how Rio prepares for Carnaval at a samba school. See colorful floats, try on splashy costumes and learn some samba moves!

**Corcovado Mountain & the Rio Botanical Garden.** Travel to the top of Corcovado Mountain to see Rio's Christ the Redeemer statue. Tour the exquisite Botanical Garden of Rio de Janeiro, home to 6,500 plant species and 140 bird species.

**Santa Teresa.** Visit the artsy Santa Teresa district and explore this lively historic district. Start at the Parque Glória Maria, a cultural center with a stunning view of Rio.

**Pelourinho.** Get to know Pelourinho, the heart of the historic center of Salvador. It holds the grim distinction of having had the first slave market in the Americas, but a rich culture developed at this crossroads of indigenous, African and European influences.

**Percussion Workshop.** Drummers from Bahia are famous for creating African-influenced rhythms. Learn the local techniques on different types of drums.

**Casa de Iemanjá & Rio Vermelho Street Food Experience.** Learn about Candomblé, an Afro Brazilian religion, during a visit to a temple. Continue to Rio Vermelho, Salvador's lively bohemian neighborhood and entertainment district, for an evening outing and a sampling of local cuisine.

**Terreiro, the Heart of the Candomblé Community, & São Joaquim Market.** Learn more about Candomblé at a house of worship. Then, walk through the lively São

Joaquim Market, where vendors sell fruit, vegetables, crafts, and religious items.

**Bahia Folk Dancing.** Watch a performance of the acclaimed Balé Folclórico de Bahia. Watch dances inspired by Candomblé; capoeira, the Brazilian martial art; and working in sugarcane fields.

**Capoeira.** Marvel at a demonstration of Brazil's unique martial art.

**Rosary of the Blacks Church & the Terça da Benção.** Glimpse a traditional service at the historic Rosary of the Blacks Church. Continue to the Tuesday of Blessing street festival, which originated as a weekly Carnaval rehearsal for a percussion group.

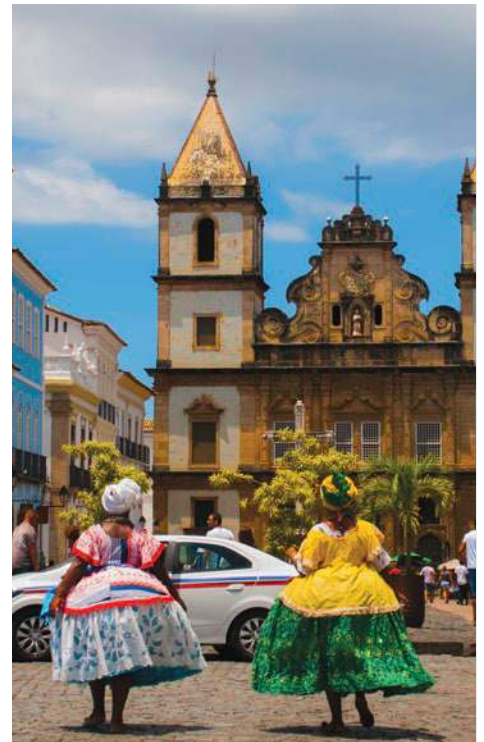
