Journey through a colorful landscape into the foothills of the Atlas Mountains to visit a local family and learn about Berber culture and experience their generous nature.

Rabat. Marvel at the grandeur of the Royal Palace's ornate façade and continue for a walk through the whitewashed homes of Kasbah des Oudaias. Admire two celebrated landmarks: the Mausoleum of Mohammad V and the Hassan Tower. Step inside the Mausoleum of Mohammad V, the resting place of past kings, and gaze at the minaret of Hassan Tower. Cap off the day at the ruins of the Citadel of Chellah.

Meknes & Volubilis. Uncover Meknes and the well-preserved remains of its royal palace. Marvel at the intricate architecture of Bab Mansour, the monumental gateway opening to El Hedim Square. Continue to Volubilis, the largest Roman archaeological site in Morocco, boasting impressive ruins.

Fes. Explore this multifarious city with over 12 centuries of history. Wander the bustling medina and see the Nejjarine Fountain at its heart. Spend the day uncovering the many historical and cultural landmarks of Fes.

Casablanca. Soak up the energy of the central piazza, Place Mohammad V and admire the city's brilliant architecture. Enjoy a visit to the Hassan II Mosque and marvel at the richly decorated interior of this spectacular religious building.

Monuments of Marrakech. Begin at the impressive Ben Youssef Medersa, an icon of Andalusian-Arabic architecture. Continue to the shaded souks and witness the hum of local culture while roaming the markets. Next, thrill to the sight of the Palais Bahia, the Koutoubia Mosque and Jemaa el-Fnaa, a gathering place and performance space for fire-eaters, storytellers and musicians.

Cooking and Calligraphy. Learn to prepare traditional Moroccan recipes and uncover the sophisticated art of Arabic calligraphy.

Gardens and Souks. Witness the Jardin Majorelle, designed by French painter Jacques Majorelle. Visit the nearby Yves Saint Laurent Museum, which boasts a collection of haute couture. Peruse an array of vibrant, colorful Moroccan spices and herbs during a guided tour of the souks.

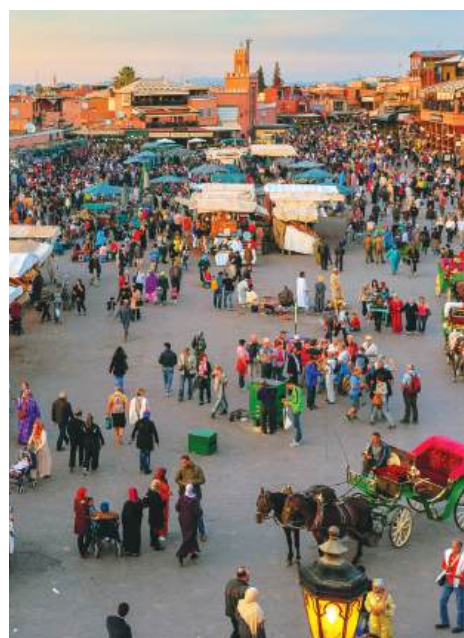

A World of Discovery

AHI Connects | Rice Noodles. In Siem Reap, a local family opens their home to share secrets of making Cambodian rice noodles, part of their rich culinary tradition.

Bangkok. Discover daily river life as you cruise the Chao Phraya River and Thonburi canals. Disembark to visit the Grand Palace and Emerald Buddha Temple, followed by a tuk-tuk ride to see the Reclining Buddha. Then, savor a fusion of old and new recipes during lunch at the famed Blue Elephant.

Ayutthaya. Visit the Bang Pa-In Palace, a summer residence for the kings of Thailand. Continue to ancient Ayutthaya for a glimpse into Thailand's regal past. Once the heart of a powerful kingdom, this historic city is now home to beautiful brick ruins, lion statues, seated Buddha figures and other amazing artifacts.

Siem Reap. Discover this provincial capital during a tuk-tuk tour and visit an art and dance center to see artisan demonstrations.

Angkor Wat. Marvel at bas-relief murals and more at this 12th-century crown jewel of the park and the world's largest temple.

Cultural Performances. Admire traditional artists bringing their cultural heritage to life through captivating performances. Attend a Cambodian circus to see an impressive acrobatic demonstration.

Angkor's Temples. Discover the impressive Angkor Thom, home to the imposing Bayon temple. Explore Ta Prohm, a Buddhist monastery swathed by massive tree roots. Continue to admire the exquisite Apsara carvings at Thommanon, a notable example of grand Khmer temple architecture.

Highlights of Hanoi. Uncover the rich history and iconic structures within the capital city of Vietnam. Begin with a visit the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum to pay respects at Ho Chi Minh's monumental tomb. Behind the complex, see his tranquil home overlooking a lotus pond. Then, stroll through the tree-lined streets of Hanoi and admire centuries-old architecture with French colonial influence, prominent in the Hanoi Opera House.

Hanoi Hilton. Relish an exclusive guided visit to the Hoa Lò Prison. Originally used by the French colonists in Indochina for political prisoners, the prison was later nicknamed "Hanoi Hilton" by American prisoners during the Vietnam War.

Ha Long Bay. Sail through the spectacular Ha Long Bay, often referred to as Vietnam's eighth wonder of the world. Gaze at the limestone rising above the emerald waters, surrounded by a pristine archipelago along the coast. Experience the unique and magical landscapes of scattered islands and anchor overnight in a secluded cove.

Yen Duc Village. Visit a rural village in the Vietnamese countryside. Savor a homemade lunch, then observe skilled puppeteers during a private performance. Water puppetry is an ancient art form that offers a glimpse into Vietnam's rich cultural history and traditions.

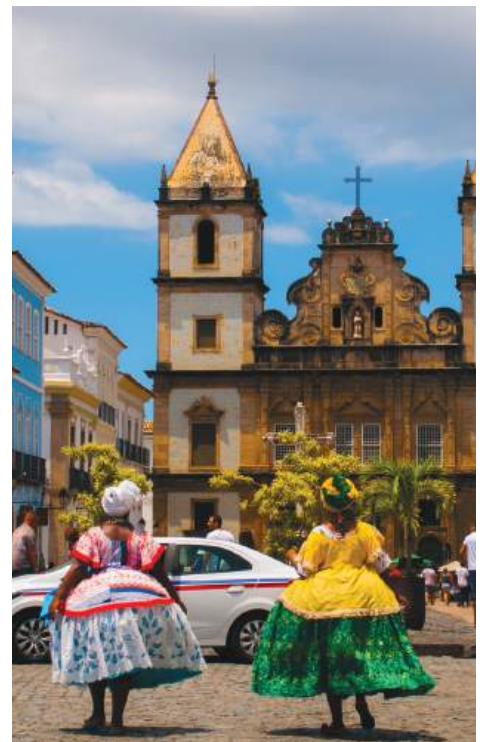

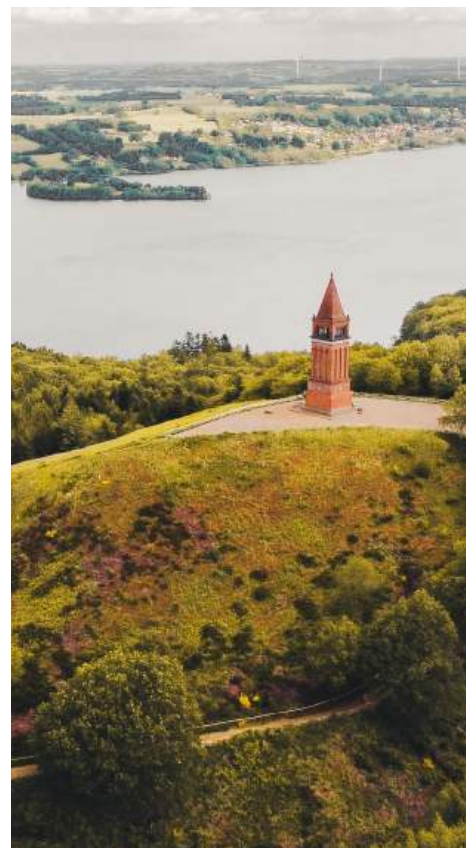

Bordeaux. Get acquainted with this dynamic wine capital on the Garonne River that brims with 18th-century architecture. On a guided walk, see the Grand Théâtre, the regal, 15th-century Porte Cailhau gate and the Place du Parlement. Gaze over the expansive Miroir d'Eau, a reflecting pool in front of the elegant Place de la Bourse.

La Cité du Vin. 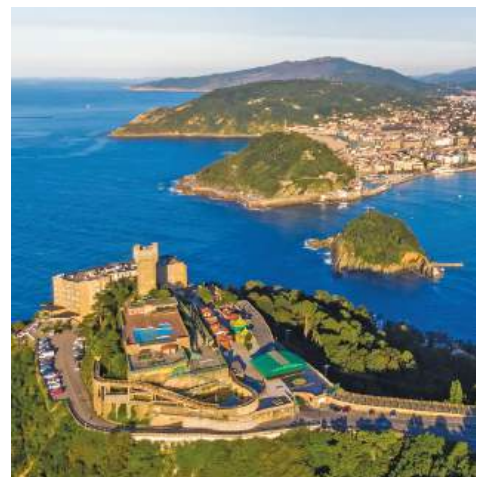

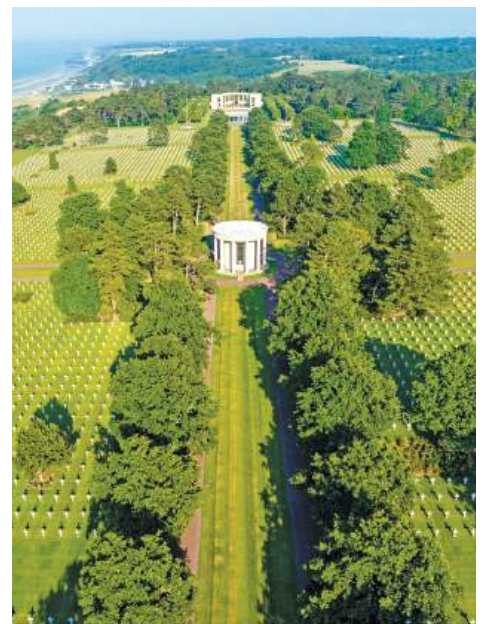

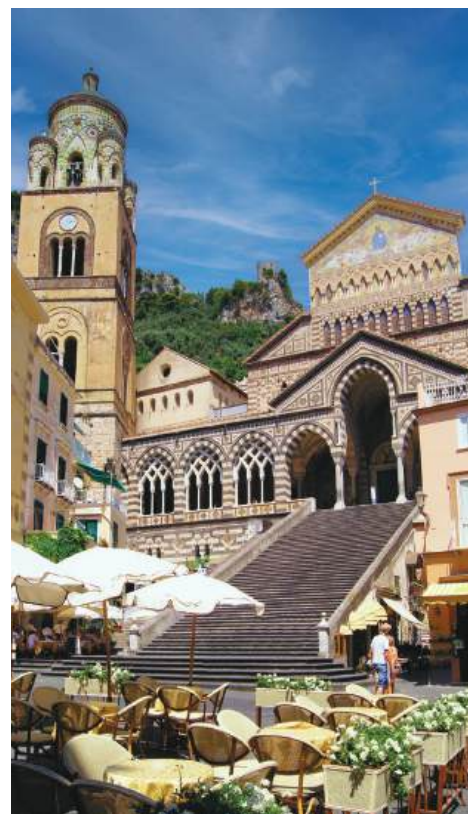

Mdina, Rabat & Hagar Qim. Stroll through charming Mdina, Malta's ancient walled capital, and admire the regal city gate, the homes of Malta's noble families and St. Paul's Cathedral. Nearby, see Rabat's landmarks and visit Domus Romana, a museum on the site of a Roman house. Head next to the coast and marvel at the impressive Hagar Qim temples, built more than 5,500 years ago with massive stones.

Valletta. Spanning almost 8,000 years, Malta's rich history includes periods of rule by the Phoenicians, Romans, Byzantines, Arabs, the Order of St. John and the British, among others. 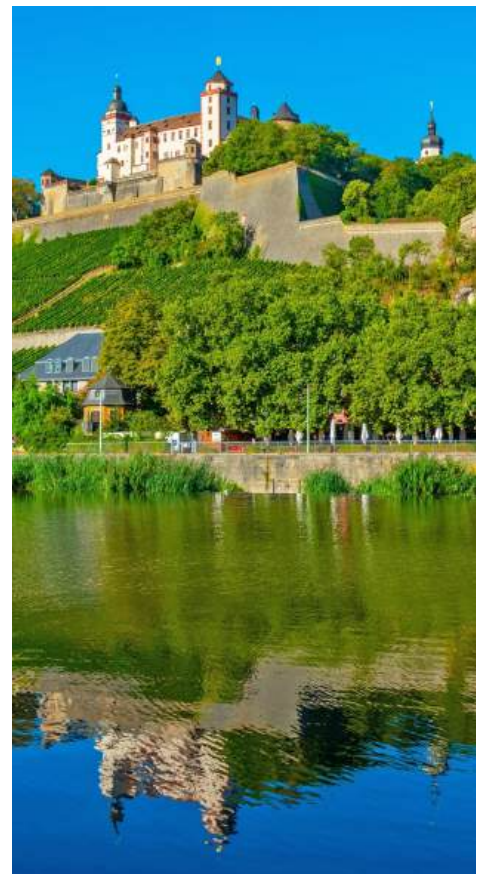

Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM). Packed with thousands of stunning relics that span from pre-history to the Roman era, the GEM also boasts Tutankhamen's burial treasures, an incomparable trove of 5,000 objects displayed together for the first time since the discovery of his tomb in 1922.

Prague's Old Town. Set out on a guided walk in this historic capital known as the City of a Thousand Spires. Stroll the heart of the old town while admiring the colorful baroque and Gothic architecture. Stop at the Astronomical Clock, installed in 1410, to witness the hourly "Walk of the Apostles," a mesmerizing display of storytelling, spiritual symbolism and medieval mechanics.

Enjoy a Welcome Reception and Dinner at Casa García Alvarado, a National Historical Building. Tour this elegant, private home and savor a meal with one of the owners.

Highlights of Lima. Begin at the Larco Museum to see its fine collection of pottery, jewelry and artifacts that spans more than 5,000 years of pre-Columbian Peruvian history. Next, admire the stately colonial-era buildings that line Plaza Mayor in Lima's historic center before pausing for lunch. Continue to visit the splendid Cathedral of Lima and the beautiful Monastery of Santo Domingo, a religious complex with relics of important Peruvian saints. Later, tour Casa Aliaga, a delightful gem built in 1535 that is still occupied by descendants of the Aliaga family. See its grand rooms richly adorned in wood and the serene courtyard.

Sacred Valley. Take in the circular Moray Terraces created by the Inca in the 15th century as an experimental farm, and visit the striking Maras Salt Mines, where salt has been extracted from terraced pools for centuries. In a mountain village, learn about ancient weaving methods and life in this challenging environment. You'll also explore Ollantaytambo, an Inca fortress notable for its immense hillside terraces. While in the Sacred Valley, enjoy lunch at a family estate that boasts gorgeous views and artwork.

Machu Picchu. Situated at an elevation of 7,972 feet in a misty cloud forest high in the Andes, Machu Picchu is considered the most important archaeological site in the Americas. With an expert guide, meander through the grassy plazas, stone temples and palaces of these stunning Inca ruins.

Cusco, Ancient Inca Capital. Perched 11,152 feet above sea level, this sacred city was the Inca Empire's religious and administrative center. Enjoy guided visits to the Cathedral in the Plaza de Armas noted for its colonial art, and the Santo Domingo Church built on the foundations of the Koricanha Temple, the Incas' main site dedicated to the worship of the sun.

Sacsayhuaman. Marvel at these massive Inca stone ruins precisely constructed without any mortar. This ancient fortress was the site of a fierce battle between the Spanish and Incas in 1536.

Cruising the Amazon Basin. Set out aboard skiff boats, anticipating the day's astounding and unexpected wildlife encounters. Pacaya Samiria National Reserve, the region in which the ship cruises, is one of Peru's largest wildlife preserves with rich

biodiversity spread across more than five million acres. Skim along rivers and creeks, peeking into lagoons and other waterways where an abundance of wildlife hides in the deep rain forest. Marvel at gray and pink dolphins swimming nearby. With your expert guide, hike in to the rain forest to explore the fantastic flora and fauna. You'll likely see brilliant parrots, hummingbirds, hawks and "laughing" falcons. Sharp eyes may spot red howler monkeys, iguanas and sloths.
